

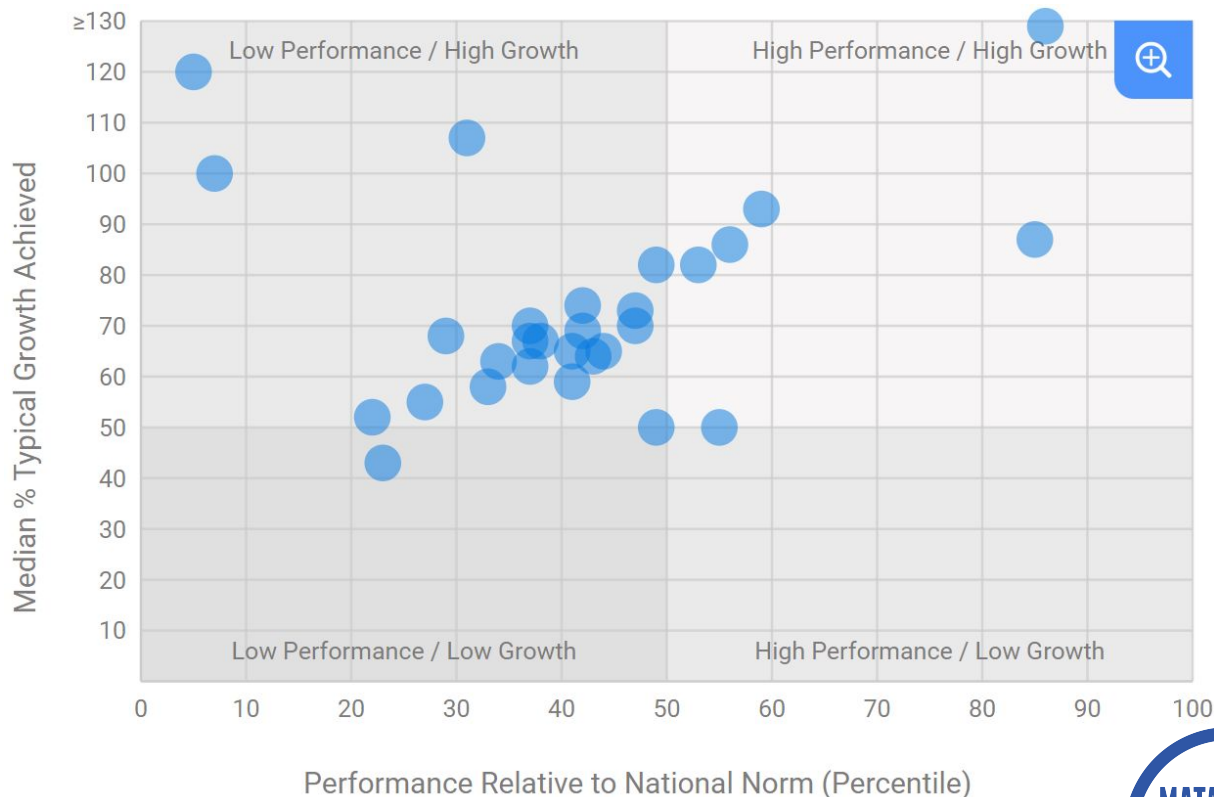

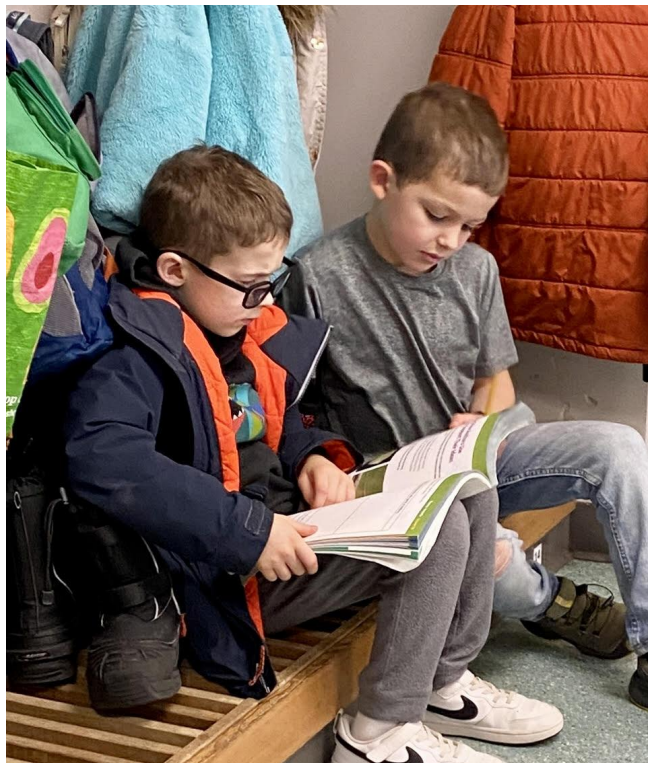

Alaska Reads Act **in Action!**

Typical growth goal is 50% by mid-year. The Majority of schools have met and exceeded this goal so far. I-Ready is Criterion Referenced.



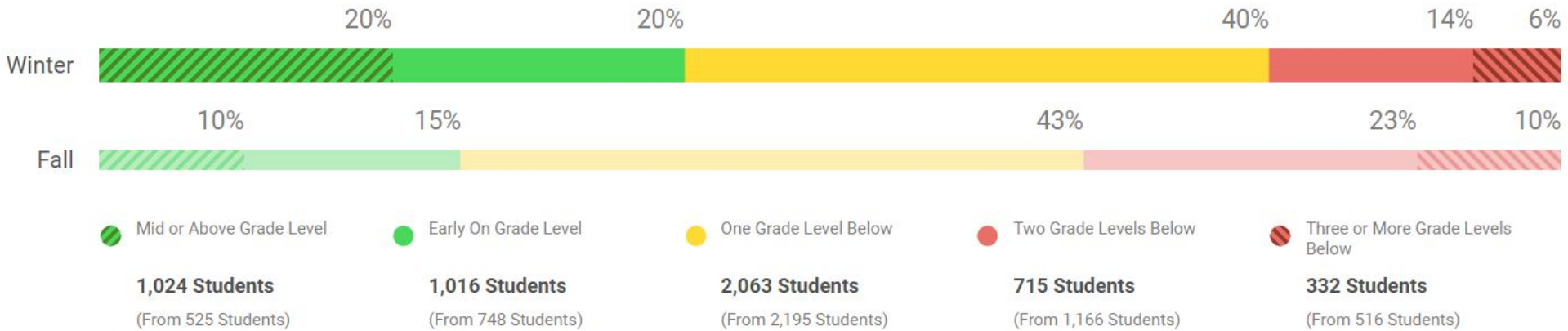
School Typical Reading Growth



Note:

All but one elementary school made at least 50% annual typical growth, and that school is at 43%, just missing the 50% mark, but of their population 36% improved from their original placement.

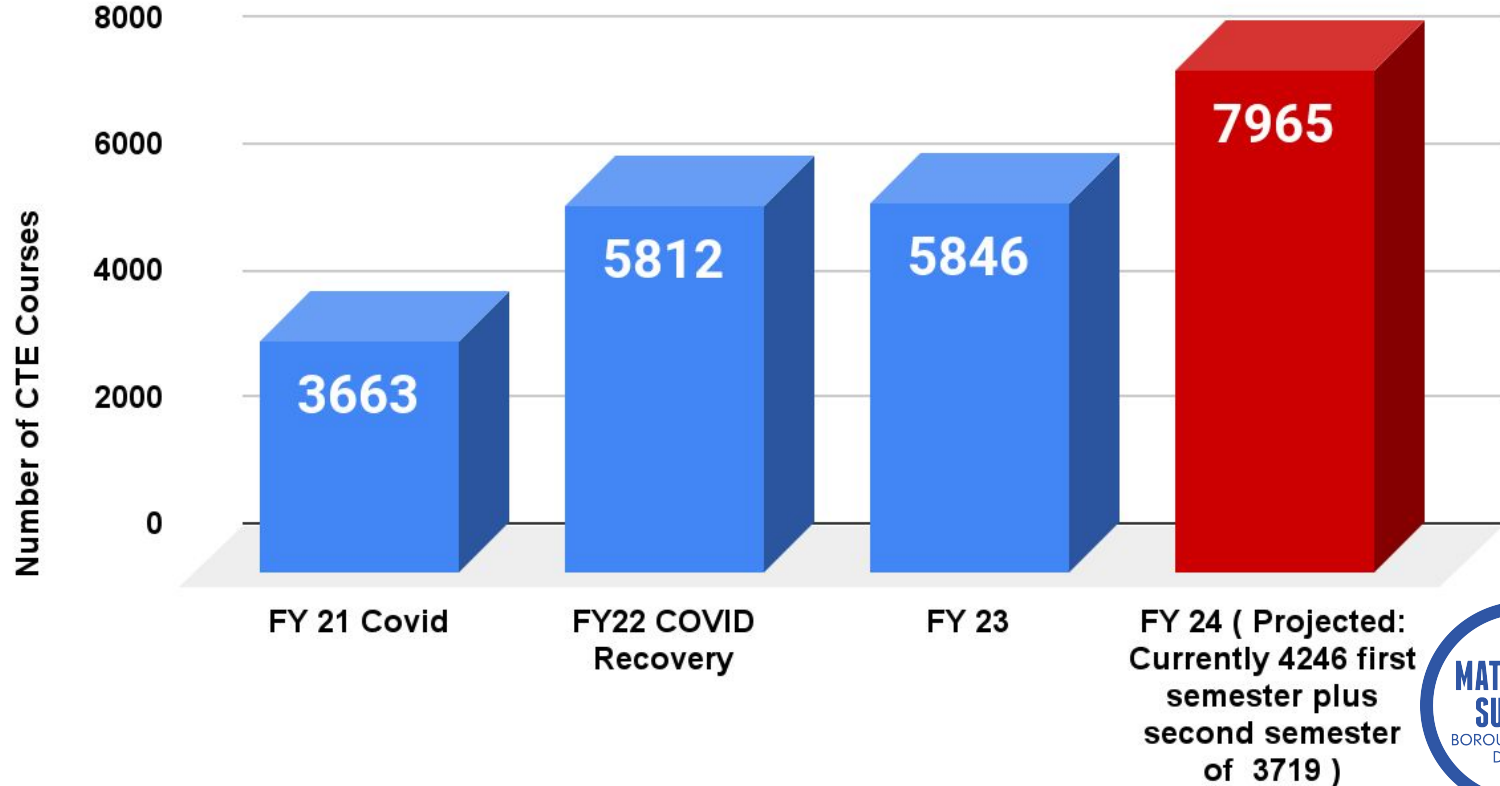

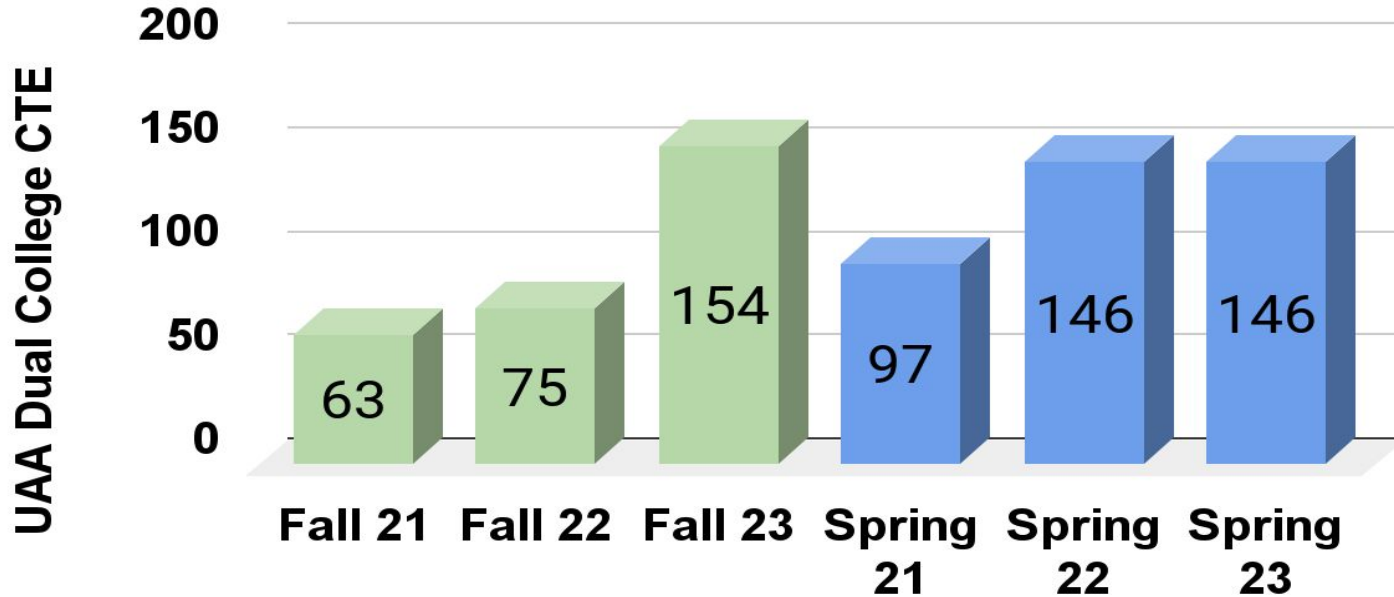

Number of CTE Courses at MSBSD



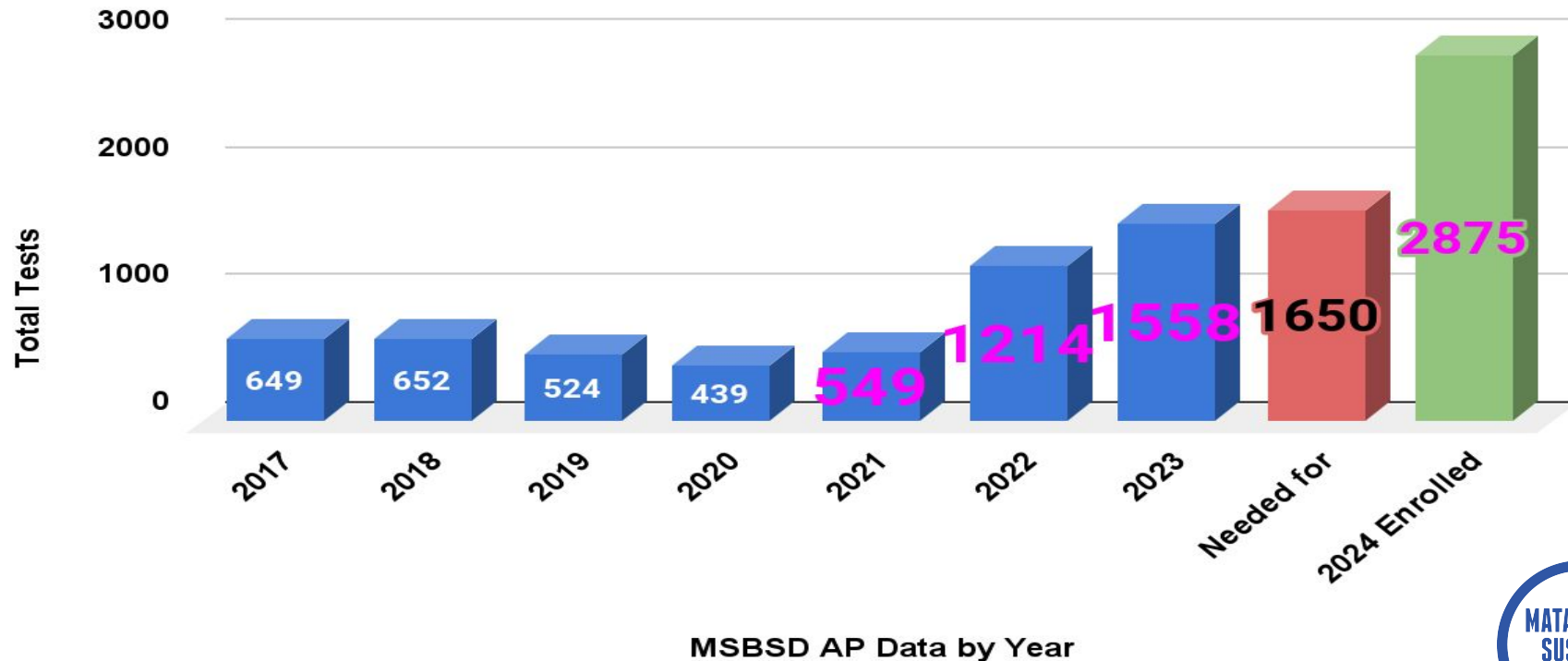

UAA Dual College CTE Credit Students MSBSD 21-23 (3 credit courses)



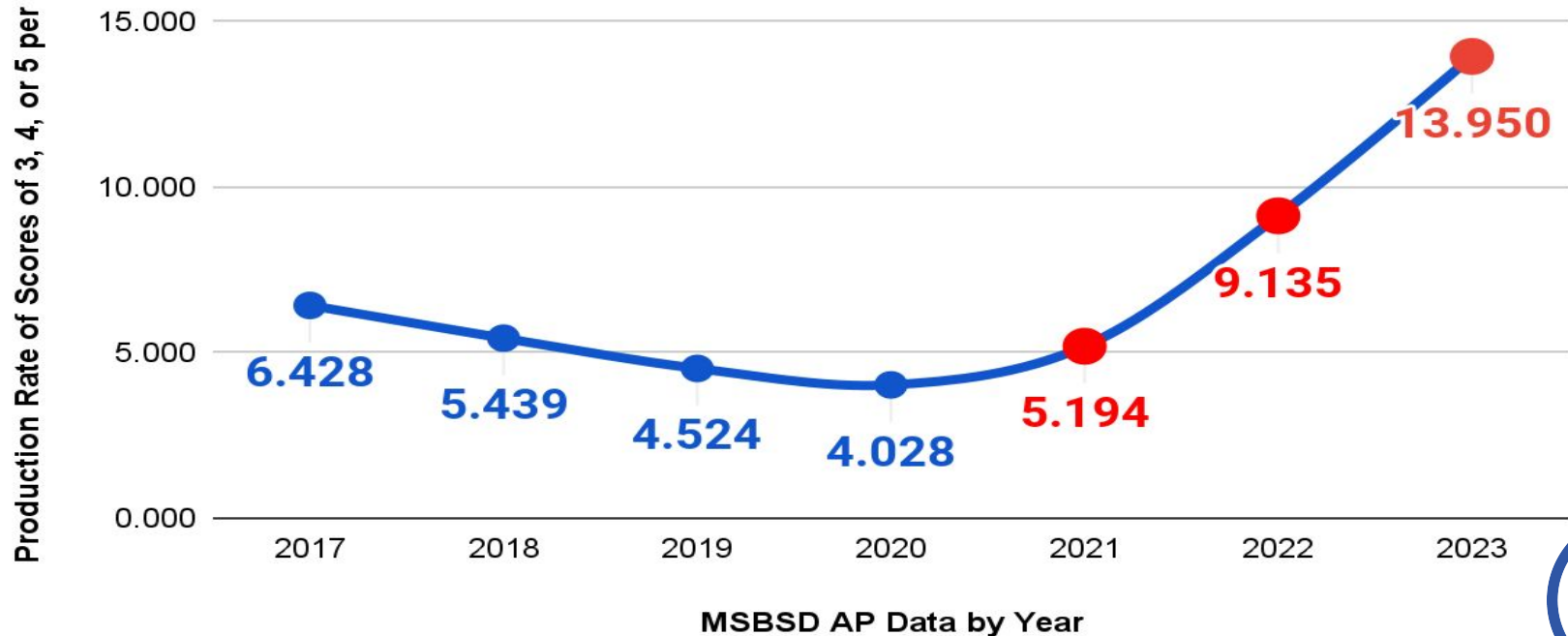

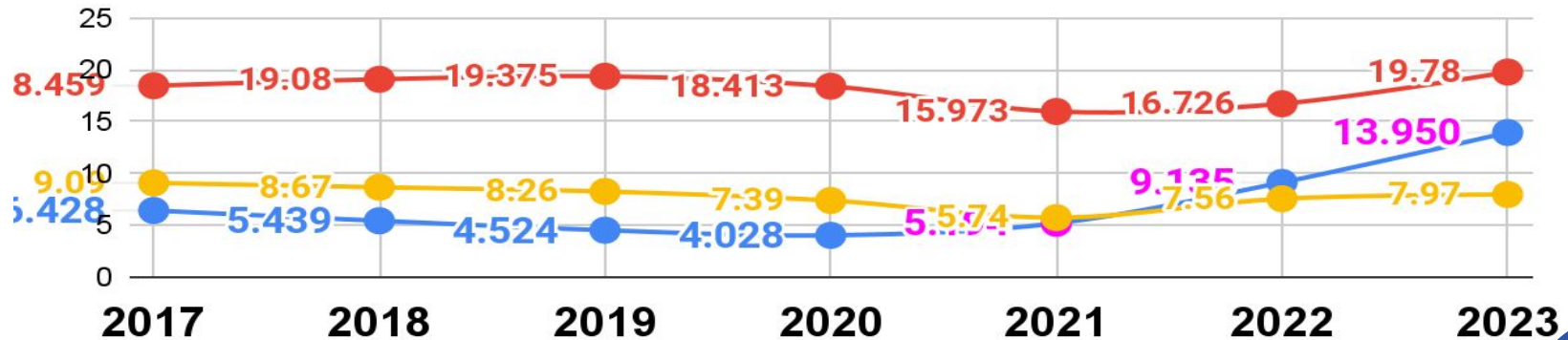
Production Rate of AP Scores of 3, 4, or 5 per 100 students

MSBSD, State Production Rate of AP Scores of 3, 4, or 5 per 100 HS Students and US

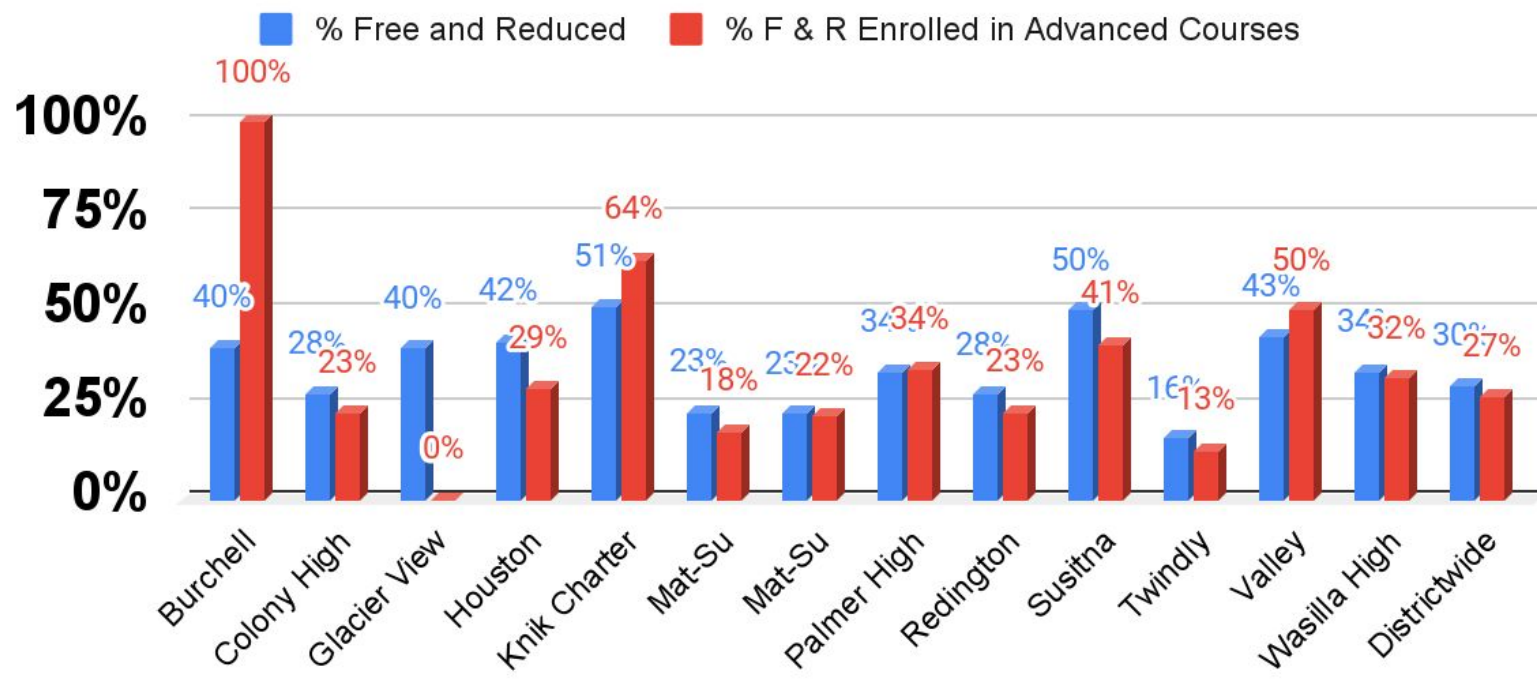

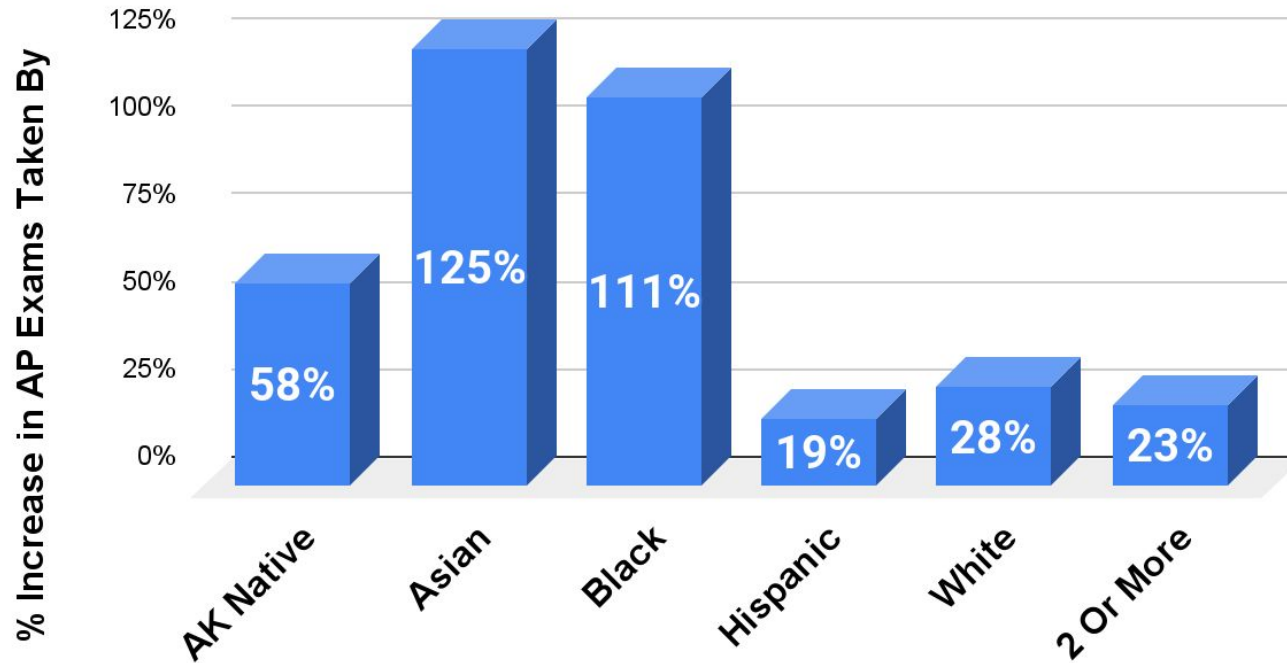

% Free and Reduced and % F & R Enrolled in Advanced Courses First Semester 2023



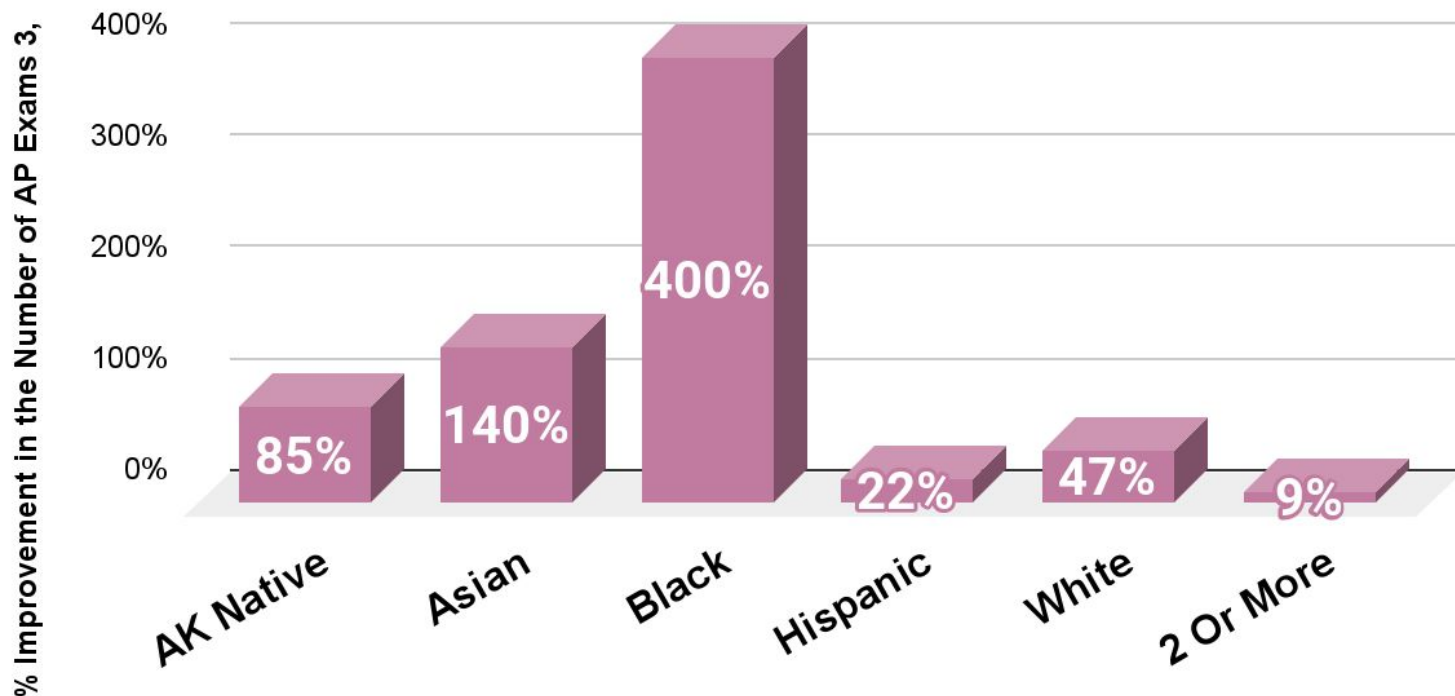

% Increase in AP Exams Taken By Race/Ethnicity YOY



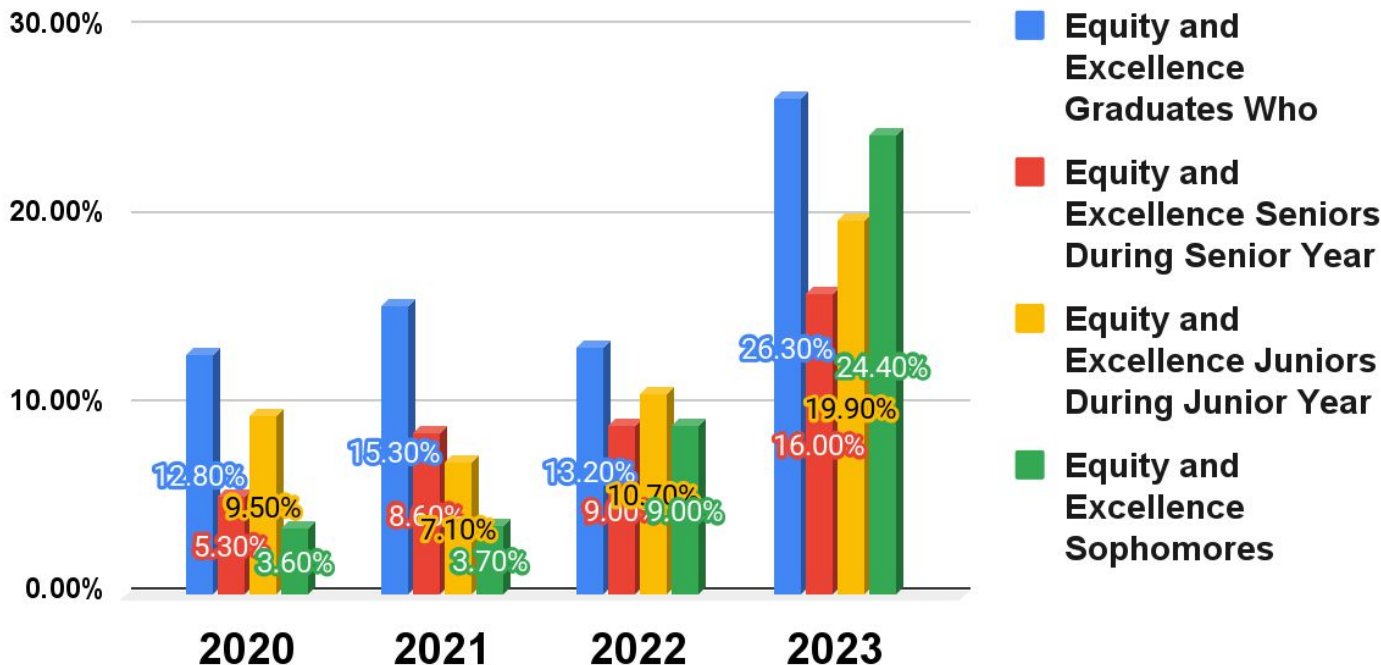

% Improvement in the Number of AP Exams 3, 4, or 5 by Race/Ethnicity YOY2023



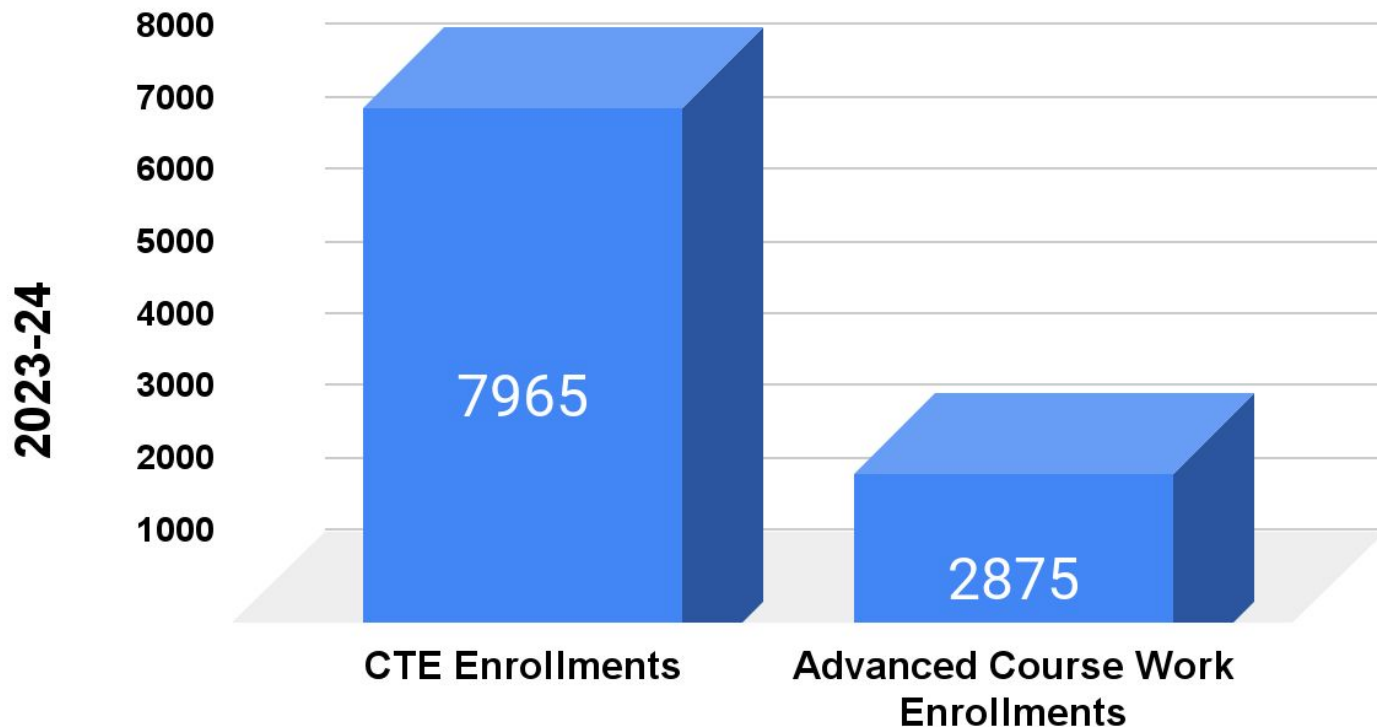

Equity And Excellence Earning 3,4,or 5 by Grade Level Over Time at the MSBSD

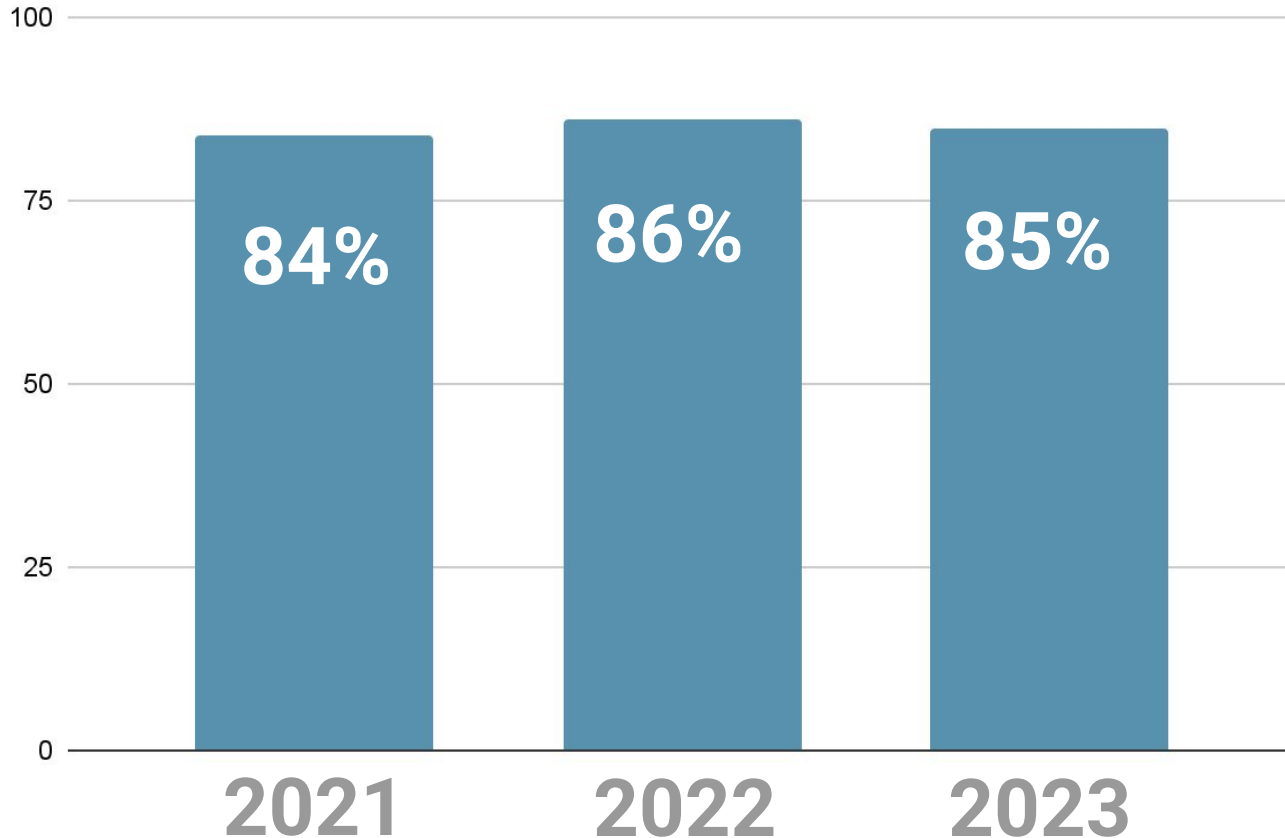

MSBSD CTE Enrollments V. Advanced Enrollments 2023-24

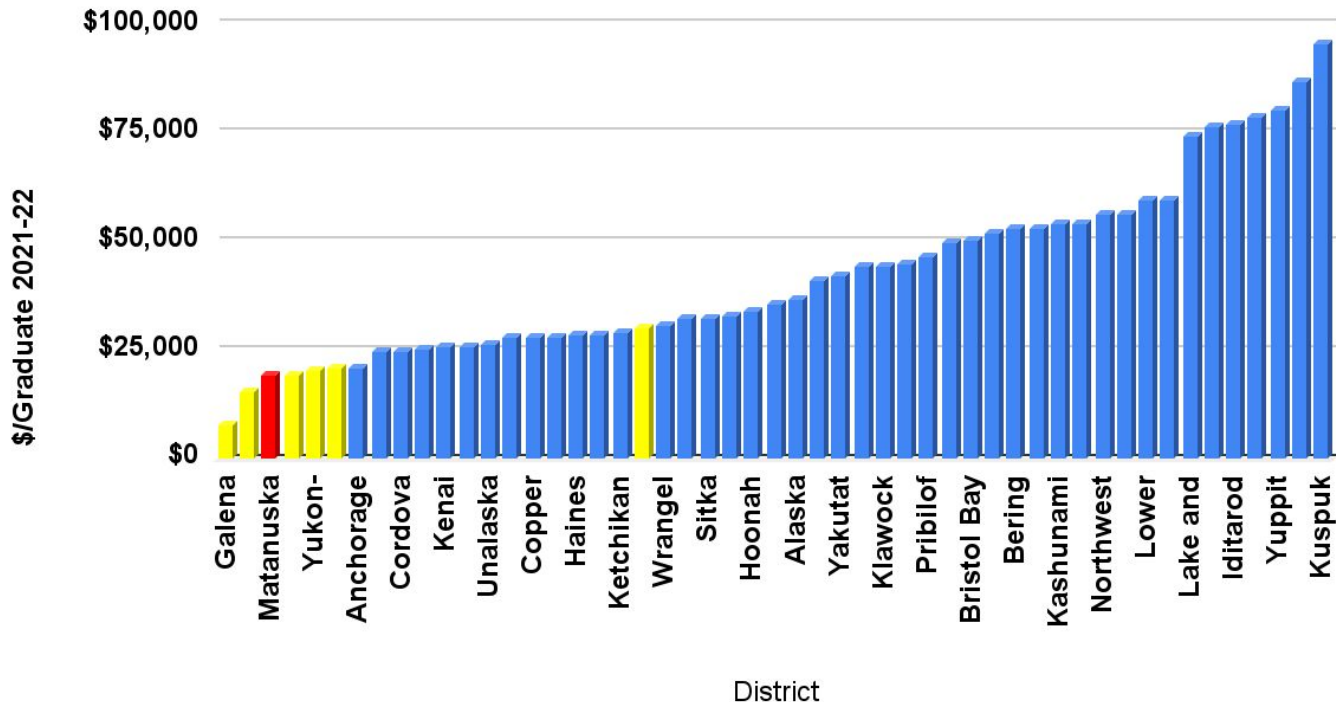


Student Achievement: Graduation Rate

\$/Graduate 2021-22 vs. District All Districts with Data

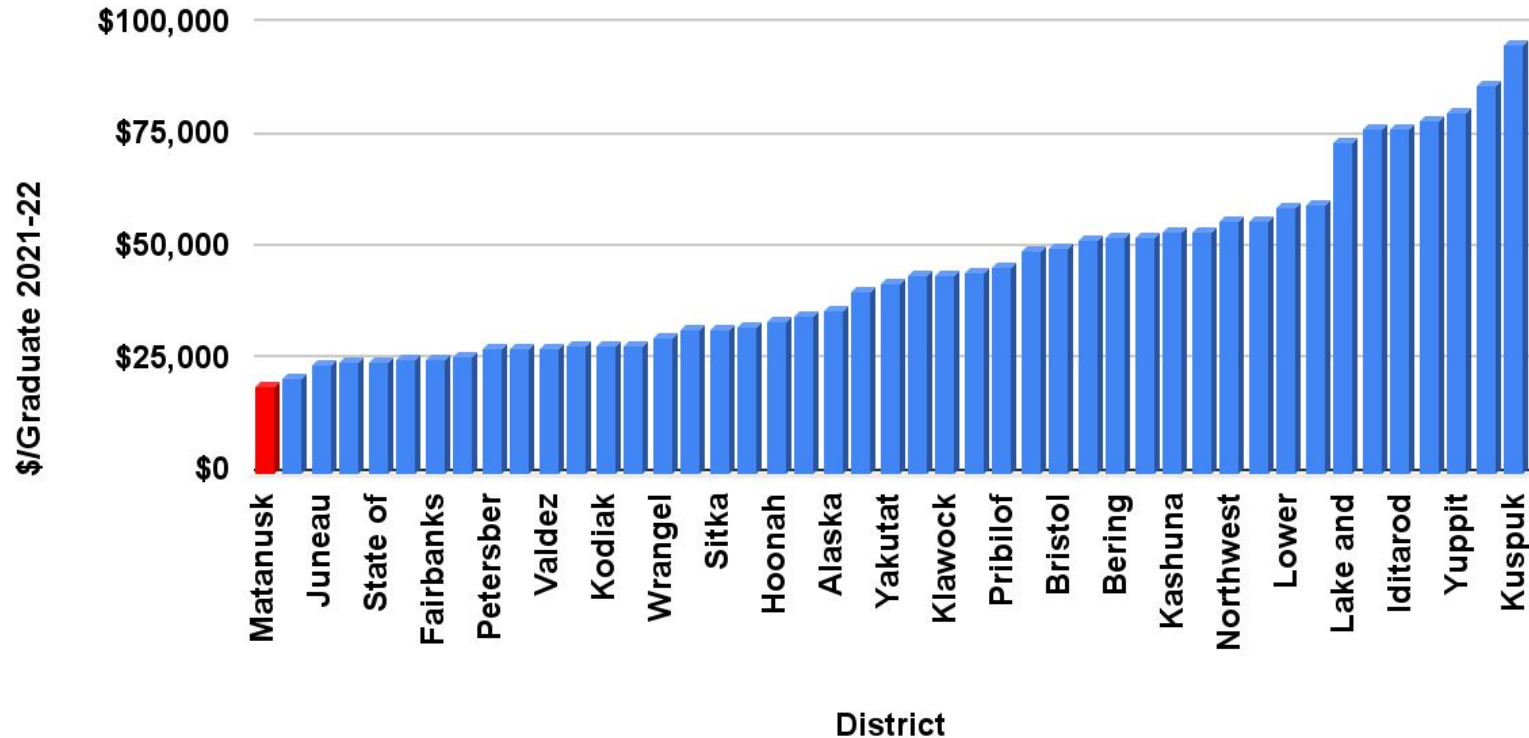


