Advertisement (1pg) Bid Analysis (3pp)

SUMMARY STATEMENT: As part of the development of the second and last segment of the railroad alignment from Port Mackenzie to Houston, Reddane Avenue needs to be connected to Point MacKenzie Road. This will then serve as a collector road providing access for the farming community and rail yard development off Guernsey Road. This new connection will be designed and constructed with two 12-foot lanes with 4-foot shoulders and 3-foot flat bottom ditches for additional snow storage. The base bid segment of the project extends west one-half mile off the Point Mackenzie Road at approximately MP 12.3 which will create a new 4-way intersection at Alsop Road. The add-alt portion of the project begins one-half mile west of Point MacKenzie Road at the end of the base bid segment and extends west to connect with Reddane Avenue.
