**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 22-017**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING AN ADDITIONAL \$210,000 FROM THE ALASKA STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES TO FUND 480, PROJECT NO. 47038, REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION ORGANIZATION FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF PREMETROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION PLANNING EFFORTS.

WHEREAS, the Borough has received an amendment to Addendum A & B of The Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Alaska State Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) and the Borough, to support continued Premetropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) development activities for fiscal year 2022; and

WHEREAS, the objective of the amendment to Addendum A & B is to finalize the draft Operating Agreement for the Mat-Su MPO and to present the documents to the Governor in September of 2022; and

WHEREAS, the ADOT&PF and the Borough share a mutual desire to ensure that future federal requirements for a new MPO are met as expeditiously and efficiently as possible; to ensure increased mobility, improved accessibility, and safer freight and passenger transport within any current or future Urbanized Area(s) in the Borough; and

WHEREAS, The ADOT&PF has set aside an additional \$210,000 of federal transportation planning funds in federal fiscal year 2022 to assist with these efforts; and

WHEREAS, ADOT&PF requires a 9.03 percent non-federal match for these funds; and

WHEREAS, project no. 47038, Regional Transportation Organization, has a balance of \$88,237.90 of which \$20,845.33 of the funding will be used to meet the required 9.03 percent match requirement.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. The Assembly does hereby authorize the acceptance and appropriation of \$210,000 from the Alaska State Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to fund 480, project 47038.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
