Areawide Fund – Non-Departmental (Tab B, page 65) and School Debt Service Fund (Tab L, page 473)

I move to amend the budget as follows and make any other conforming changes to the budget:

- The Areawide Fund, Non-Departmental, Transfer to Debt Service (School) (445.140) by striking \$25,122,121 and inserting \$23,493,561 in its place. This is a decrease of \$1,628,560.
- The School Debt Service Fund by striking Transfer from Areawide (300.000.000.367.110) by striking \$25,122,121 and inserting in its place \$23,493,561. This is a decrease of \$1,628,560.

The above reduction will reduce the areawide mill rate by .136 mills

Areawide Fund – Non-Departmental (Tab B, page 65) and Education Fund (Tab I, page 424 and 423)

I move to amend the budget as follows and make any other conforming changes to the budget:

- The Areawide Fund, Non-Departmental, Transfer to Education Operating (445.220) by striking \$72,008,566 and inserting \$70,696,614 in its place. This is a decrease of \$1,311,952.
- The Education Operating Fund by striking Transfer from Areawide (204.000.000.367.110) by striking \$72,008,566 and inserting in its place \$70,696,614. This is a decrease of \$1,311,952.
- The Education Operating Fund by striking from Education Operating (204.000.000.406.100) \$259,860,695 and inserting in its place \$258,549,013. This is a decrease of \$1,311,952.

The above reduction will reduce the areawide mill rate by .109 mills

Areawide Fund - Non-Departmental (Tab B, page 62)

I move to amend the budget as follows and make any other conforming changes to the budget:

- The Areawide Fund Marijuana Tax by striking \$1,500,000 and inserting \$1,840,000 in its place. This will result in an increase of \$340,000; and,
- The Areawide Fund Tobacco Excise tax by striking \$8,500,000 and inserting \$8,990,000 in its place. This will result in an increase of \$490,000.

The above increase of \$830,000 in revenues will reduce the areawide mill rate by .069 mills. This aligns projected revenues from these sources with what was collected in the 2020-21 fiscal year, and reduces the areawide mill rate thereby providing relief to property owners boroughwide.

Areawide Fund - Non-Departmental (Tab B, page 53, 58 & 62)

I move to amend the budget as follows and make any other conforming changes to the budget:

• The Areawide Fund mill rate by reducing it by .133 mills. This will result is a \$1,600,000 reduction to areawide unassigned fund balance, leaving a balance of \$500,000.

The above reduction will reduce the areawide mill rate by .133 mills, which will reduce the tax burden on property owners boroughwide.
