# SUMMARY STATEMENT:

AGENDA OF: April 5, 2022

ASSEMBLY ACTION:

In accordance with State statutes, on January 4, 2022, the Assembly adopted Resolution Serial No. 22-004, and it's accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 22-012. This resolution found that the existing apportionment of the Assembly does not meet the equal representation standard required under Alaska Statute 29.20.060(A) and is therefore malapportioned. It further directed that administration initiate the necessary steps for preparing information and alternatives for Assembly District apportionment, and to prepare an ordinance providing for a change in the existing apportionment to be placed before the voters.

Current & Proposed Assembly District Maps and Proposed Assembly with New Precincts (14 pp)

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Alaska Statute 29.20.080(a) states that not later than two months after adoption of a final State redistricting plan, the Assembly must determine if the existing apportionment of Assembly Districts meets State and Federal standards. In anticipation of this requirement on February 16, 2021, Information Memorandum Serial No. 21-032 was presented to the Assembly, outlining the process that would be used to reapportion Assembly Districts based on 2020 Census Data.

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic and its associated shutdowns the release of the data files from the 2020 Census, originally set for release in March 2021, were delayed until August 12, 2021, and therefore the State redistricting process was not completed until November 12, 2021.

Borough staff secured the ESRI Redistricting software and in late January began drawing new Assembly District boundaries. Using the criteria outlined in Information Memorandum Serial No. 21-032.

# **BACKGROUND:**

The 2020 decennial census determined the population for the Borough to be 107,081. When this number is divided by the current number of Assembly Districts, the target population for each Assembly District, to assure that residents are equally represented, is 15,297. Using data released by the U.S. Census Bureau on August 12, 2021, staff has made a preliminary determination of the population for each current Assembly District as of April 2020:

There is at present an estimated total deviation of 24.29 percent between the population of the district with the largest population, District 5, and the district with the smallest population, District 1.

# STAFF PRELIMINARY PLAN:

Using the current Assembly Districts as a starting point and keeping the previously established goals and criteria, as outline

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in Information Memorandum Serial No. 21-032, in mind, staff drafted a number of potential plans. The population growth in Assembly Districts 5 and 6 put them much higher than our target population of 15,297 and that additional population needed to be spread out to cover the shortages in the other districts.

Staff made every effort to keep Assembly and School Board Members within their districts, however, due to population, house district and precinct boundaries, we were not able to do so. All Assembly Members will remain in their districts, and so will four of the School Board Members. The remaining three School Board Members will now be in a different district which will result in the truncation of their term. The school board members for Districts 3, 5 and 6 no longer reside within the new district lines.

In addition to the population and deviation by District, staff also looked at racial statistics. Racial statistics are evaluated to ensure that when moving lines we do not inadvertently draw a district that divides a minority population and reduces their ability to elect fair representation.

Historically the Mat-Su has had a fairly consistent percentage of American Indian and Alaska Native (AIAN) residents within each district. The current Assembly Districts (AD), as approved during the reapportionment following the 2010 Census, indicated that there was between 8.2 percent and 11 percent AIAN in each district. All other races were under the one percent mark and therefore not tabulated in our review.

The 2020 Census data shows an increase in overall population as well as an increase in the AIAN. In addition we now have a growing number of Hispanic or Latino (HL) residents. This increase puts our ideal AIAN population at 1,872 and ideal HL population at 749, per assembly district.

Prior to this reapportionment process the AIAN in each district ranged from 1,345 in District 1 up to 2,774 in District 5. In an

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effort to keep those numbers consistent, the proposed plan slightly adjusts those numbers and the AIAN now ranges from 1,479 in District 1 and up to 2,500 in District 5. The AIAN and HL populations are fairly consistent throughout the borough before reapportionment and our proposed plan of apportionment does not change that.

## ASSEMBLY DISTRICT LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS:

In developing a plan for reapportionment staff used the 2020 Decennial Census blocks. Census blocks are required to follow natural features to the greatest extent possible. During the Participant Statistical Area Program (PSAP) completed in preparation for the 2020 Census, staff met with the US Census GIS staff to correct the Census Blocks that cut through structures due to subdivision growth and in an effort to alleviate issues when drawing new districts. During this process we were able to eliminate or combine some of the Census Blocks with zero population that are in lakes and rivers, and we hope to eliminate additional zero population blocks during the next PSAP process.

Staff attempted to use major roads, local roads, rivers and streams as the boundaries between Assembly Districts to the greatest extent

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possible. The Mat-Su Borough will be retaining the services of a company to work with the Borough Clerk and Staff on drafting the written legal descriptions for staff's plan, and for any amendments the Assembly may adopt. It is the intent that the legal descriptions be based off of the final reapportionment plan map adopted by the Assembly.

The staff proposed plan followed the process outline in Informational Memorandum No. 21-032:

- 1. Seven Assembly Districts, each with a member elected from the district by the voters of the district;
- 2. Each district was developed by using the existing districts as a starting point;
- 3. Existing Assembly Members home addresses were marked in the software, with the addition of new addresses if the member was planning to move before the next regular election;
- 4. Preserves all municipal boundaries;
- 5. Preserves communities of common interest;
- 6. Creates compact districts; and
- 7. Follows natural features where possible; and
- 8. Over all deviation of the staff proposed plan is 8.29%, under the required 10%.

## SPECIAL ELECTION

The qualified voters of the borough must vote on (1) a form of Assembly representation pursuant to Alaska Statute 29.20.070(b), and (2) a plan of apportionment that corresponds to that form of representation pursuant to Alaska Stature 29.20.080(a). The Staff proposed plan provides for both of these requirements.


A special election must be held in order to avoid multiple split precincts at the regular election in November. The elimination of split precincts will reduce the chances of errors and reduce costs.




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
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




































#### 2.12.010 ELECTION.

(A) The borough assembly shall consist of seven members elected from districts as follows:

thence running with the boundary of Assembly District No. 7 southeasterly on West Denali Highway to its intersection with Brushkana Creek located in Section 11, Township 19 South, Range 3 West, Fairbanks Meridian, Alaska; thence southerly, westerly, southwesterly, southeasterly and southwesterly along Brushkana Creek to its intersection with the township line between Section 33, Township 19 South, Range 3 West and Section 4, Township 20 South, Range 3 West, Fairbanks Meridian, Alaska; thence northerly to the section corner common to Section 3 and Section 4, Township 17 North, Range 3 West and Section 33 and Section 34, Township 18 North, Range 3 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence westerly along the township line between Section 4, Township 17 North, Range 4 West and Section 33, Township 18 North, Range 4 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska to its intersection with the Little Susitna River; thence southwesterly along the Little Susitna River to its intersection with the section line between Section 4 and Section 5, Township 17 North, Range 4 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence southerly along the section line between Section 4 and Section 5. Township 17 North, Range 4 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska to the section corner common to Section 4, Section 5, Section 8 and Section 9, Township 17 North, Range 4 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence westerly along the section line between Section 5 and Section 8, Township 17 North, Range 4 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska to the East 1/16 corner common to Section 5 and Section 8, Township 17 North, Range 4 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence southerly to the Southeast 1/16 corner in Section 8, Township 17 North, Range 4 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence westerly to the Center South 1/16 corner in Section 7, Township 17 North, Range 4 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence northerly to the Center 1/4 corner in Section 6, Township 17 North, Range 4 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence westerly to the southeastern shore of Butterfly Lake in Section 6, Township 17 North, Range 4 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence southwesterly, northerly, southerly, northerly along the bank of Butterfly Lake to its intersection with the township line common to Township 17 North, Range 5 West and Township 18 North, Range 5 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence westerly along the township line between Section 1, Township 17 North, Range 5 West and Section 36, Township 18 North, Range 5 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska to its intersection with Tract A-1, Adams Subdivision Unit #3; thence northerly, westerly and southerly along the boundary of Tract A-1, Adams Subdivision Unit #3 to the northeast corner of USS 4638; thence westerly along the north boundary of USS 4638 to a non-visible point along the north boundary of USS 4638; thence northerly to a point on the township line between Township 17 North and Township 18 North, Range 5 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence westerly along the township line between Township 17 North and Township 18 North, Range 5 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska to its intersection with Tract Q-1, Red Shirt Lake Subdivision; thence southwesterly along the boundary of Tract Q-1, Red Shirt Lake Subdivision to the southeasterly corner of Tract Q-1, Red Shirt Lake Subdivision; thence westerly along the boundary of Red Shirt Lake Subdivision to the corner common to the southwest corner of Tract U-1, Red Shirt Lake Subdivision and USS 3223; thence westerly along the boundary of USS 3223 to its intersection with Fish Creek; thence southwesterly downstream along Fish Creek to a non-visible point in Fish Creek located in Section 6, Township 17 North, Range 5 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence southwesterly, northwesterly, northerly and northeasterly on a non-visible point-to-point line to a point on the section line between Section 31, Township 18 North, Range 5 West and Section 6, Township 17 North, Range 5 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence westerly along the section line between Section 31, Township 18 North, Range 5 West and Section 6, Township 17 North, Range 5 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska to an unnamed creek intersecting the section line between Section 34, Township 18 North, Range 6 West and Section 3, Township 17 North, Range 6 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence southwesterly and westerly along the unnamed creek to its confluence with an unnamed creek in Section 3, Township 17 North, Range 6 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence southwesterly along the unnamed creek to its confluence with the Susitna River along the East bank of the Susitna River in Section 4, Township 17 North, Range 6 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence downstream along the East bank of the Susitna River to a non-visible point near the mouth of the Susitna River along the banks of Knik Arm in Section 34, Township 14 North, Range 7 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence southeasterly to a non-visible point in Cook Inlet in Section 1, Township 12 North, Range 7 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska, being also the junction of Assembly District No. 5 and Assembly District No. 7 along the boundary of the Matanuska-Susitna Borough; thence running with the boundary of the Matanuska-Susitna Borough southwesterly, northwesterly, northerly, westerly, northerly, westerly, northerly, easterly, northerly, northerly and easterly to its intersection with West Denali Highway located along the section line between Section 23 and Section 26, Township 18 South, Range 4 West, Fairbanks Meridian, Alaska, being also the junction of Assembly District No. 1 and Assembly District No. 7 along the boundary of the Matanuska-Susitna Borough, and the point of beginning of this description.
