MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 22-009

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING, AND APPROPRIATING A PORTION OF THE 2018 COOK INLET EARTHQUAKE DISASTER RELIEF MONIES, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$18,371,035.57, \$13,778,276.68 FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY AND \$4,592,758.89 FROM THE ALASKA STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, FOR THE HOUSTON MIDDLE SCHOOL REBUILD; AND REAPPROPRIATING \$11,900,000 BACK TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, \$1,725,446 TO SCHOOL BOND DEBT SERVICE AND \$890,521 TO THE SCHOOL SITE SELECTION RESERVES; AND RESCOPING \$1,500,000 TO THE HOUSTON JR/SR HIGH SCHOOL REPAIRS PROJECT FROM THE HOUSTON MIDDLE SCHOOL REBUILD PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale for this ordinance are found in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 22-014, and Resolution Serial No. 22-005.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. The Assembly does hereby authorize the acceptance and appropriation of \$18,371,035.57, \$13,778,276.68 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency And \$4,592,758.89 from the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management to fund 400, project no. 40204, Houston Middle School Rebuild.

Section 3. Reappropriation Source. The Assembly does hereby authorize the reappropriation of \$11,900,000 from Houston Middle

School Rebuild fund 400, project no. 40204 to the School District fund 204.

Section 4. Reappropriation Source. The Assembly does hereby authorize the reappropriation of 1,725,446 from Houston Middle School Rebuild Fund 400, project no. 40204, to fund 300 School Bond Debt Service.

Section 5. Reappropriation Source. The Assembly does hereby authorize the reappropriation of \$890,521 from Houston Middle School Rebuild fund 400, project no. 40204, to fund 100 Reserve for School Site Acquisition.

Section 6. $\underline{\text{Effective Date}}$. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
