**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 22-050**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL DISASTER RELIEF FUNDS FOR THE 2018 NOVEMBER COOK INLET EARTHQUAKE.

WHEREAS, On November 30, 2018 the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained severe damages to Borough roads, schools, public facilities and infrastructure due to a magnitude 7.0 earthquake; and

WHEREAS, a local, state and federal disaster declaration was issued; and

WHEREAS, costs incurred during the disaster were determined to be eligible for state (25%) and federal (75%) funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Borough was awarded \$293,322.29 for PW227 for repairs to fire stations throughout the Borough; and

WHEREAS, repair costs are higher than anticipated, and

WHEREAS, Amendment 5 was issues as a cost adjustment increasing the award amount by \$8,913.50.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation source. The Assembly hereby approves the acceptance and appropriation of federal and state grant funds on the total amount of \$8,913.50 to fund 445, project no. 55027 for increased costs for repairs caused by the 2018 November Cook Inlet Earthquake.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.

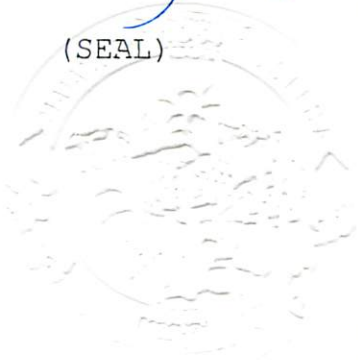
