SUMMARY STATEMENT: On February 21, 2025, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Purchasing Division issued a solicitation requesting Proposals from qualified firms to supply a Fire Prevention Trailer to support fire prevention education and training programs. This trailer will serve as a mobile unit, providing hands-on learning experiences for community members, including school groups, local businesses, and seniors about fire safety and emergency preparedness. Goods purchased will support the Emergency Services Department in all assembly districts.

One proposal was received in response to the advertisement. Central Mat-Su Fire Chiefs reviewed the proposal, which determined that JHB Group can supply the training trailer the Borough needs. JHB Group was identified as the most advantageous firm for the Borough. The final completion date for this project is October 31, 2025

Project Overview: The Matanuska-Susitna Borough is seeking to procure a Fire Prevention Trailer to support fire prevention education and training programs. This trailer will serve as a mobile unit, providing hands-on learning experiences for community members, including school groups, local businesses, and seniors about fire safety and emergency preparedness. The purpose of this Scope of Work is to establish the basic requirements and allow fire staff to specify minimum technical and performance criteria.

Scope of Work:

1. General Requirements:

- The trailer must be a turn-key solution designed for fire prevention demonstrations and educational outreach that includes specific, localized messages and props.
- The unit should be suitable for transport on public roads, meeting all applicable federal and state safety regulations.
- The trailer must be durable and capable of withstanding various weather conditions experienced in Alaska.
- All equipment, materials, and components included in the trailer should be new and free of defects.
- The Borough anticipates this trailer to cost less than \$240,000.

2. Minimum Specifications:

The fire prevention trailer should meet or exceed the following minimum specifications. Please provide the necessary details under each section:

• Trailer Size and Dimensions:

- Desired trailer length 27'
- Desired width and height: 8.5' x 10.5'
- Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR): 9,000 lbs.

 - 1. Integrated and built in props need to be capable of creating a realistic training environment.

• Exterior Features:

- Entry and exit doors with safety features: ADA compatible with multiple point of ingress and egress to include safety ramp and applicable hand and or grab rails.
- Power supply requirements:4500-watt dual fuel generator. 200-watt solar charging system. Inverter with master power switch and 30-amp electrical panel.

• Exterior graphics or branding options: Full wrap customizable graphics package. This will be imperative to providing a specific localized message to the public.

• **Operational Requirements:**

- Climate control needs: Heater for inside and outside demonstration rooms as well as an exhaust fan for interior demonstration rooms.
- Storage compartments for additional training materials and supplies.
- Any other specific requirements: Minimum of 16' power awning that will provide protection while viewing exterior TV.


3. Delivery and Warranty:

- Vendor shall deliver the trailer to Port of Anchorage via Seattle Washington and ensure that it is in ready-to-use condition.
- A comprehensive warranty must be provided for all components of the trailer, including a minimum warranty period of 1-year limited warranty and 5 year structural warranty.
- The vendor should provide a detailed operations manual and training session upon delivery.
