AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING  
THE LAND CLASSIFICATION OF A BOROUGH-OWNED PROPERTY AS RESERVED  
USE LAND FOR THE PURPOSE OF A SHOOTING RANGE

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WHEREAS, the intent and rationale are contained within the  
Information Memorandum No. 26-022 and the Best Interest Finding  
attached thereto; and

WHEREAS, borough-owned land shall be classified in accordance  
with Title 23, and such classification shall be used as a tool to  
identify and guide future development of such land; and

WHEREAS, land classification cannot be changed without  
Planning Commission review and Assembly approval; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission adopted Resolution Serial  
No. 25-30 recommending the Assembly approve the land  
classification.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a noncode  
ordinance.

Section 2. Approval. Assembly hereby approves the land  
classification of a portion of tax parcel 18N03W09A001, lying North

of W. Zero Lake Road as reserved use land for the purpose of a shooting range.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
