SUMMARY STATEMENT: This resolution is sponsored by the Borough Manager to allow the Matanuska-Susitna Borough to provide Borough owned earth materials for use in completing the Port MacKenzie Rail Extension project. Rather than have the Borough derive income from any sale of the materials, the Alaska Railroad Corporation can use the value of the materials as match participation in a Consolidated Rail Infrastructure and Safety Improvements grant. Award of the grant will bring the PMRE closer to completion, complete a major Borough infrastructure priority, and further spur development of Port MacKenzie.

If approved in concept, a future ordinance will be presented furthering the details of the earth materials disposal.
