## MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 22-019

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY REAPPROPRIATING \$1,000,000 FROM THE EMERGENCY RESPONSE RESERVE FUND 100, TO FUND 445, PROJECT NO. 55030, FOR THE 2022 WINDSTORM DISASTER.

WHEREAS, beginning January 1, 2022, The Borough experienced a winter storm that brought extreme cold weather and sustained strong winds. Impacts from the storm included multi-day power disruptions, windblown debris and downed trees blocking transportation infrastructure and damage to public, private and commercial property; and

WHEREAS, a disaster declaration in response to the storm was signed by the Manager and Mayor on January 3, 2022; and

WHEREAS, a declaration of disaster emergency in response to the storm was signed by the Governor of the State of Alaska on January 6, 2022; and

WHEREAS, \$1,000,000 needs to be reappropriated from the emergency response reserve, fund 100, to fund 445, project no. 55030.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Reappropriation Source. The Assembly does hereby reappropriate \$1,000,000 from the emergency response reserve, fund 100, to fund 445, project no. 55030 Windstorm Disaster.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
