MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO.21-049

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING A REAPPROPRIATION OF \$12,500 FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT OPERATING BUDGET 203.170.141, TO PROJECT NO. 15040, FUND 440, SETTLERS BAY COASTAL PARK PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Borough received property from the Great Land Trust identified as the Settlers Bay Coastal Park, which abuts the Knik Arm in the Settlers Bay and Secluded Point subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly adopted Ordinance Serial No. 18-050, approving the Settlers Bay Coastal Park Recreation Development Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Department has applied for a \$21,000 grant from the Matsu Trail and Park Foundation, with a \$10,500 match required, for further development of the park in 2021.

WHEREAS, the Borough has identified and plans to apply for additional grant funding programs with match requirements to further develop Settlers Bay Coastal Park to include revitalization of the Wet Gulch historic trail, more interpretive signage, and construction of more trails and bike park; and

WHEREAS, reappropriating \$12,500 from the Land Management fiscal year 2021, Operating Budget, 203.170.141, to the project account ensures availability of matching funds for future needs and development in the Park; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Manager authorized the request to seek
Assembly reappropriation of the operating budget funding.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Re-appropriation. The Assembly hereby reappropriates \$12,500 from fiscal year 2021 Land Management Operating Budget, 203.170.141, to the Settlers Bay Coastal Park, project no. 15040, fund 440.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
