Scopes of Work

15050 - Jay Nolfi Park

Funding will be used to improve existing facilities at the Jay Nolfi/Fish Creek Park by providing equitable access to park amenities, this will include expanding and paving pathways, and adding accessible playground equipment, as described in the approved Capital Improvement program.

10022 - Gateway Visitor Center

Funding will be used as match for the EDA grant, to replace the match funding that was used for required services not authorized by the EDA grant.

99999 - State and Federal Grant Match

This funding will be used to meet the required match on state and federal grants received by the Borough.
