


**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** This resolution is coming at the request of Mayor Devries.

The State of Alaska (SOA) Adopt-A-Highway (AAH) program participants pick up refuse along State-maintained roads within the Matsu Borough and are charged with disposing of the refuse under the AAH program guidelines. This program was suspended until recently, due to COVID restrictions.

Currently, the Solid Waste Division (SWD) charges for all waste brought into the Central Landfill and Transfer Stations, unless it is disposed under an approved Mat-Su Borough (MSB) Community Cleanup. Because the MSB Community Cleanup Program does not include State-maintained roads, the refuse collected and brought in by SOA AAH participants is charged at the current Assembly approved rates.

The SOA AAH staff has requested the SWD waive all fees for refuse collected on state roads within the Matsu Borough from this AAH program, and brought in by their SOA AAH participants to the SWD.

The costs to SWD for this disposal is typically less than \$5,000 annually.

MSB Code 8.05.090(C) does not allow for free waste disposal, except by Assembly resolution. Therefore, it is requested that fees be waived for this SOA AAH program, within the Borough, through June 30, 2023. The specific details of how to administer the program is to be determined by the Solid Waste Division and the State of Alaska Adopt-A-Highway staff.
