

**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 18-001**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY DECLARING
THE BUFFALO MINE/SOAPSTONE COMMUNITY COUNCIL INACTIVE.

WHEREAS, Section 2.76.040(B) of the Borough code specifies that the Planning Department shall, at least once every three years, submit to the Planning Commission and Assembly a report and recommendation on community council boundaries; and

WHEREAS, MSB 2.76.030(C) states that "The Planning Commission may recommend to the Assembly that the previously recognized community council be declared inactive if the community council has failed to meet the following requirements:

- (1) The community council has not held a minimum of two meetings during the previous calendar year.
- (2) The community council has failed to inform the borough administration of current officers with appropriate addresses and telephone numbers.
- (3) The community council has failed to comply with the requirements to maintain recognition as specified in MSB 2.76.030(B)."

WHEREAS, during the last boundary review, the Planning Department discovered that the Buffalo Mine/Soapstone Community Council no longer meets the minimum requirements of MSB 2.76.030, and should be declared inactive; and

WHEREAS, at the January 15, 2018, public hearing the Planning Commission adopted Resolution No. 18-003 recommending Assembly approval of the declaration of inactive status for the Buffalo Mine/Soapstone Community Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly hereby declares the Buffalo Mine/Soapstone Community Council as inactive pursuant to MSB 2.76.030(C):

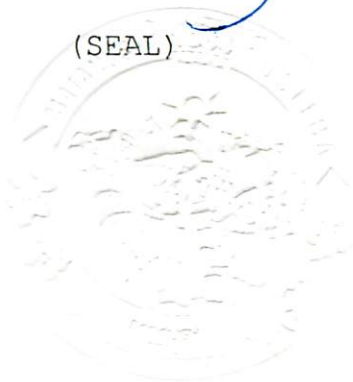
