**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO.18-106**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$100,000 FROM THE MAT-SU TRAIL AND PARK FOUNDATION TO FUND 440, PROJECT NO. 15040, TO DEVELOP THE SETTLERS BAY COASTAL PARK (MSB007387).

WHEREAS, the Borough received property known as the Settlers Bay Coastal Park abutting Knik Arm in the Settlers Bay and Secluded Point subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the property is of great value to the residents of the borough and the state of Alaska in general, and is worthy of preservation due to its significant aquatic and wildlife resources, and diverse terrain of upland forest, estuarine, riparian, riverine, and wetland habitat that directly contributes to the health of the ecosystem in the region; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly adopted the Settlers Bay Coastal Park Recreation Development Plan at the regularly scheduled meeting June 19, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Department has partnered with Great Land Trust on a Mat-Su Trail and Park Foundation grant application for development of the park; and

WHEREAS, the Mat-Su Trail and Park Foundation approved the application and awarded Grant No. 2018-402 in the amount of \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used to develop the park in accordance with the conservation easement and adopted recreation development plan with a completion date in 2020.

BE IT ENACTED:


Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance. The Assembly hereby accepts \$100,000 from the Mat-Su Trail and Park Foundation for development of the Settlers Bay Coastal Park.

Section 3. Appropriation source. There is hereby appropriated by the Assembly \$100,000 from the Mat-Su Trail and Park Foundation, to fund 440, project no. 15040 for development of the Settler Bay Coastal Park.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
