A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR FUND 480, PROJECT NO. 47045, FOR A PAGER UPGRADE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Department of Emergency Services utilizes emergency response analog paging notification technology to alert and activate emergency responders to respond to calls for service; and

WHEREAS, the current system is based on antiquated analog technology from the 1980's; and

WHEREAS, with the availability, reliability, redundancy, security, and delivery capabilities, digital technology is now less cost prohibitive; and

WHEREAS, in order to improve the Borough's communications capability, redundancy, and reliability, we are requesting to replace the analog system with a new digital paging system and pager equipment; and

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$473,000 to upgrade the Borough pager system were reappropriated to fund 480, project no. 47045, from the Areawide Fiscal Year 2018 Telecommunications Operating Budget fund 100, with Assembly adoption of Ordinance Serial No. 18-064.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the scope of work and budget for project no. 47045 as follows.


