SUMMARY STATEMENT: Following the November 2018 Cook Inlet Earthquake, four locations (S. Vine Road, Point MacKenzie Road, Settler's Bay Road, and S. Trunk Road) sustained damages that required the Borough to make emergency repairs. The repairs were later determined ineligible for federal reimbursement by FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Agency) because they are designated as FWHA (Federal Highway Administration) roads. However, the emergency repairs are eligible for reimbursement (100%) from the Alaska State Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management. The attached

amendment, once approved and executed, will allow the state reimbursement of emergency repairs.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: Respectfully request adoption of the legislation to accept, appropriate, and approve the scope of work and budget for \$382,762.00 of additional funds for the 2018 Cook Inlet Earthquake disaster.
