SUMMARY STATEMENT:

With Ordinance 2016-016, \$3,300,000 was appropriated to project 10183-6601 for the construction, furniture, fixtures, and equipment for a new Station 6-2 and with Ordinance 2017-008, an additional \$4,874,486.64 was added to this project to complete the build and purchase of needed items for the new Station 6-2. The construction and purchase of furniture, fixtures, and equipment for the new Station 6-2 is now complete and there is a remaining balance in the project in the amount of \$739,004.30.

The old Station 6-2 is currently being utilized as the logistics warehouse and will need renovations, upgrades, and the addition of

a fire suppression sprinkler system to make the building safe and functional.

The Central Mat-Su Fire Service Area is developing additional training features for their training complex such as a vehicle extraction area, driving operator skills area, technical rescue area, hazmat training area and a live fire prop exercise area.

The Central Mat-Su Fire Service Area Chief is requesting a revision in the scope of work to include upgrades to the old Station 6-2 and a build out of the training complex.
