SUMMARY STATEMENT: On January 16, 2024, the Assembly approved the Road Improvement List - 2024, which included the E. Jupiter Ave. & N. Diana Ave. Improvement Project. The E. Jupiter Ave. & N. Diana Ave. Improvement Project includes East Jupiter Avenue and North Diana Avenue, located within Road Service Area 19 Lazy Mountain. The Project Number is 30041 (18-19-1450). As part of the design process, utilities review the project design to determine if there are conflicts with their utilities. If conflicts cannot be resolved, utility relocation is required before construction.

Matanuska Telecom Association, Inc. (MTA) has planned upgrades in this subdivision. In working with the MSB, MTA's initial relocations were estimated to be \$84,202.85 for this project.

After the field conditions were verified, the initial relocation plan was changed to include an additional bore and trench length to stay out of the water in the ditch line. The additional relocation effort is estimated to cost \$22,989.46. This change is anticipated to take place after July 1, 2024, to use fiscal year 2025 funding. This additional relocation cost brings the reimbursable estimated total for all services and expenses to \$107,192.31.

The Administration requests approval for utility relocation costs of \$22,989.46 for the additional relocation on Jupiter Ave. & Diana Ave. Grading, Drainage, and Surface Improvement Project.
