MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 25-107

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE AND REQUIRED MATCH FUNDING FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 AREAWIDE BUDGET APPROPRIATION FOR COTTONWOOD CREEK AT FERN STREET FISH PASSAGE.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale of this ordinance are in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 25-205 and Resolution No. 25-089.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. The Assembly hereby accepts \$60,000 from the United States Fish and Wildlife Service National Fish Habitat Partnership, and appropriates \$60,000 to fund 410, project no. 30114, fish passage improvements. The Assembly hereby appropriates \$60,000 in match funding from the fiscal year 2023 areawide budget appropriation fund 480, project no. 99999, fund 410, project no. 30114, fish passage improvements.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
