**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** This ordinance sunsets the temporary Library Citizens' Advisory Committee, originally established by Ordinance Serial No. 24-039, prior to its original termination date. The Committee has successfully completed its intended purpose and contributed significantly to the community. To streamline operations and align with current organizational priorities, the Committee recommends transferring responsibility for challenged book procedures to the Library Board.
