**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** On May 16, 2017, Ordinance Serial No. 17-065 will be presented to accept and appropriate \$300,000 from United State Fish and Wildlife Service. Resolution No. 17-035 identifies \$300,000 of required match from the fiscal year 2012 capital projects budget for the purpose of matching grants. These grant match funds are set to expire June 30, 2017. If this extension is not approved the match money will expire and we will be unable to meet our grant agreement terms. The Public Works Department respectfully requests approval to extend the expiration date to December 31, 2018. The grant funds will also expire December 31, 2018.

The Matanuska-Susitna Borough has created a partnership with the United State Fish and Wildlife Service working collaboratively to survey, identify, fund, and remove barriers to fish passage, thus keeping our salmon populations healthy and viable.
