SUMMARY STATEMENT: On September 6, 2024, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Purchasing Division issued a solicitation requesting bids from qualified contractors to realign, upgrade and improve the drainage along 8712 linear feet of S. Vicki Way, E. Dewan Court, E. Greenstreet Circle, E. Dimond Way, S. Begich Drive, and S. Hay Street. This project will involve, but is not limited to clearing, grubbing, excavation, import and placement of borrow material, import and placement of aggregate base and surface courses, placing hot mix asphalt, installing drainage culverts and infiltration drain rock within ditches, and placing topsoil and seed. Construction Services purchased will support the Public Works Department in assembly district #3. In response to the advertisement, five bids were received. Award recommendation is being made to Granite Construction Company as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder based on Total Bid Amount.

The final completion date for this project is July 31, 2026.

Construct Midway Streets Road Improvements SCOPE OF WORK

General

This project's purpose is to realign, upgrade and improve the drainage along 8712 linear feet of S. Vicki Way, E. Dewan Court, E. Greenstreet Circle, E. Dimond Way, S. Begich Drive, and S. Hay Street. Barley Ave is excluded from this project's scope as indicated in the plan sheets. This project will involve, but is not limited to, clearing, grubbing, excavation, import and placement of borrow material, import and placement of aggregate base and surface courses, placing hot mix asphalt, installing drainage culverts and infiltration drain rock within ditches, and placing topsoil and seed.

All construction shall be completed in accordance with the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) Standard Specifications for Highway Construction (SSHC) 2017 Edition. Project specific special provisions are provided in the following sections. The requirements contained in these specifications and special provisions are hereby made a part of this solicitation and resultant contract.

- This project is located in Wasilla along E Blue Lupine Drive. S. Vicki Way, E Dimond Way, and S. Hay Street may be accessed by heading east 0.3 miles, 0.5 miles, and 1 mile on E. Blue Lupine Drive from Seward Meridian Road. E. Dewan Court, S. Begich Drive may be accessed by heading north 0.2 miles and 0.5 miles on E. Dimond Way from E. Blue Lupine Drive. E. Greenstreet Circle may be accessed by heading north 0.07 miles and 0.1 miles on S Hay Street from E. Blue Lupine Drive. See project location and vicinity maps.
- Contractor is to provide resources to complete this project without any adjustments in the original bid amount or contract time.
- Contractor is required to obtain an ADEC APDES permit prior to work activities. Utility relocation work done by the utility companies will be performed under this permit.
- Contractor shall coordinate the road improvements with all utility relocation work. Request locates from the utilities having facilities in the area. Use the Alaska Digline, Inc. Locate Call Center. See Section 105-1.06 for digline number and a list of utility companies in the area.
- Work Zone speed limit: Limit speed of vehicles associated with construction to 20 miles per hour within project limits.
- Complete work between 7 AM and 7 PM.
- The contractor is required to designate a primary point of contact for public inquiries related to the construction project. This contact person's details must be provided to the MSB Project Manager within seven (7) days of the contract award. The contact information will be included in all construction notices distributed to residents in the project area. The designated contact should be accessible during normal business hours and capable of addressing resident concerns, providing updates, and coordinating any issues that arise throughout the project with the MSB Project Manager. The contractor is responsible for ensuring that this contact information remains current and accurate for the duration of the project. Any changes to the contact information must be communicated to the MSB Project Manager within two (2) business days of the change. Additionally, the contractor should ensure that the contact person is trained and prepared to handle public inquiries effectively, including the ability to address complaints and provide timely responses.
- Alaska DOT&PF Right of Way permit is being procured and will be provided at a later date. The contractor is
 responsible for this permit's requirements, including the as-built surveys. Contractor will be responsible to apply for
 and procure a lane closure permit from DOT&PF to perform the work within DOT&PF Right of Way.
- Contractor shall complete ROW and utility easement staking and clearing and all necessary SWPPP items for utility relocation support upon NTP. This work shall be included in items 201(3B), 642(1), 641(1), and 641(3). Additional stump removal for utility support will be directed if needed and is not included in these items. The MSB Project Manager or approved representative will prepare a punch list for implementation before acceptance. See 643-3.07.
- Time is of the essence. Work shall be completed in one continuous timeframe after utility relocations are completed. Substantial completion shall be achieved by <u>09/30/2025</u>. Final completion shall be achieved by <u>07/31/2026</u>.

Estimated project magnitude is less than **\$2,660,000.**
