MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 20-082

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$100,000 FROM THE UNRESTRICTED NET ASSETS IN THE SOLID WASTE ENTERPRISE FUND, FUND 510, TO BUDGET FUND 510.150.401.426.900, TO SUPPORT OPERATIONS TO CHIP, GRIND, OR BURN DEAD SLASH FROM BEETLE KILLED TREES DISPOSED OF BY BOROUGH RESIDENTS.

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Division accepts an average of less than 500 pounds (or 0.25 ton) per month of trees and brush for disposal; and

WHEREAS, 1,007.91 tons of trees and brush were accepted for disposal for no charge during the months of April, May, and June of 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Division requires financial means expeditiously to chip, grind, or burn dead slash from beetle killed trees disposed of by Borough residents; and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund contains the funds required for this project; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work and budget are contained in Resolution Serial No. 20-082.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. The Assembly does hereby appropriate \$100,000 from the unrestricted net assets of the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund, fund 510, to budget fund 510.150.401 426.900, to support operations to chip, grind, or burn dead slash from beetle killed trees disposed of by Borough residents.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
