SUMMARY STATEMENT: On November 30, 2018 the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained damage to infrastructure due to a magnitude 7.0 earthquake. A borough, state and federal disaster declaration was issued for November 30, 2018. Allowed costs are eligible for 75% federal and 25% state funding assistance.

As a result of this disaster, Project Worksheet (PW104) was awarded in the amount of \$238,787.11 for Borough Wide Emergency Protective Measures. During the process of providing the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the state with supporting documents, we found an invoice for a post-earthquake infrastructure inspection was missed in the original submittal. The attached amendment (PW104 Version 1) is the final cost adjustment that increases the total grant award by \$390.

**RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION:** Accept, appropriate and approve the amended budget for additional disaster relief funds from the 2018 Cook Inlet Earthquake Disaster for borough wide emergency protective measures.
