**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 17-152**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY REQUESTING REAPPROPRIATIONS OF \$8,200 FROM THE BUTTE FIRE SERVICE AREA CAPITAL PROJECTS BUDGET, FUND 405, PROJECT NO. 45067-6606, TO PROJECT NO. 45067-6604, TO EXPAND THE GEAR STORAGE PROJECT; AND \$4,200 FROM PROJECT NO. 45067-6605, TO PROJECT NO. 45142-6606, TO PURCHASE COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT FOR THE COMPRESSED AIR FOAM SYSTEM TRUCK.

WHEREAS, in the 2017 Capital Projects Budget \$20,000 was appropriated for a heating system at Station 2-1; and

WHEREAS, that project is now complete and there is a remaining balance of \$8,200 available; and

WHEREAS, in the 2016 Capital Projects Budget \$30,000 was appropriated for a turnout gear storage rack which has been purchased; and

WHEREAS, further funding is desired to expand the turnout gear storage rack to include self-contained breathing apparatus equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Butte Fire Service Area Chief has requested that the remaining balance of \$8,200 from project no. 45067-6606, be transferred to project no. 45067-6604, to expand their gear storage project; and

WHEREAS, in the 2017 Capital Projects Budget \$20,000 was appropriated for Exterior Lighting Replacement; and

WHEREAS, that project is now complete and there is a remaining balance of \$4,200 available; and

WHEREAS, in the 2014 Capital Projects Budget \$50,000 was appropriated for the purchase of a compressed air foam system truck; and

WHEREAS, the compressed air foam system truck has been purchased, but there is a need for communications equipment to make the truck fully functional for response; and

WHEREAS, the Butte Fire Service Area Chief has requested that the remaining balance of \$4,200 from project no. 45067-6605, be transferred to project no. 45142-6606, to purchase communications equipment for the compressed air foam system truck; and

WHEREAS, no expenditures can be made until the scope of work and budget have been approved by the Assembly.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Reappropriation source. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly does hereby reappropriate \$12,400 from fiscal year 2017, Butte Fire Service Area Capital Appropriations, fund 405, project nos. 45067-6605 and 45067-6606, to project nos. 45067-6604 and 45142-6606, fund 405, to allow for the expansion of gear storage and compressed air foam system truck communications equipment.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
