A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING THE SCOPES OF WORK AND BUDGETS FOR PORT GRANT MATCH-FISCAL YEAR 2021 AND PICKUP 4X4 CREW CAB-PORT-FISCAL YEAR 2025, APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PORT ENHANCED SECURITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale for this resolution are found in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 25-234 and Ordinance Serial No 25-121.

Scope of Work

Port enhanced security improvements project grant and match funding will be used to purchase, design, and install enhanced security equipment and infrastructure for Port MacKenzie.
