The Community Development Department has SUMMARY STATEMENT: approximately \$12,500 in their operating budget for continued development of Settlers Bay Coastal Park. The Department is requesting approval for these operating funds to be moved into Project 15040, Fund 440, to be used for continued development of the Settlers Bay Coastal Park as provided for in the Recreation Development Plan, adopted by Assembly Ordinance Serial No. 18-050, August 19, 2018.

Re-appropriation of the \$12,500 will dedicate matching funds that are often required when securing outside grant funding. The Department has identified and has applied for a \$21,000 grant from the Matsu Trails and Parks Foundation which requires a 50% match.

If awarded, the money will be used to increase access to the park by completing the construction of the ADA Bluff Trail, the opening of two new CXT's (restrooms), and building more trails.

Additional grant opportunities are frequently identified by staff. Staff has identified and plans to apply for multiple grants in fiscal year 2022. Nearly every grant program requires the grantee to match with its own funding. Having additional funding available in a project account for the Settlers Bay Coastal Park will help guarantee the Borough can meet match requirements for future grant applications.

Accompanying Matanuska-Susitna Borough Ordinance No. 21-049 approves the re-appropriation and Resolution No. 21-052 will amend the budget to reflect the change.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: Staff respectfully requests the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly re-appropriate \$12,500 from the fiscal year 2021 Community Development Department operating budget, Fund 203-170-141, to Project No. 15040, Fund 440; and approve the amended budget for the Settlers Bay Coastal Park (Match) project.
