SUMMARY STATEMENT: In accordance with code, the District preliminary budget is due to the Assembly on April 1, 2025. The budget was received March 25, 2025.

The total school district budget request is \$281,601,753. Of that amount, they have made the request that \$78,033,127 be provided by the Borough. Resolution Serial No. 25-041 will establish the minimum amount of money from local sources to be made available for school purposes. That amount is \$49,661,045, which is the required Borough (local) contribution. This minimum required local contribution amount (\$49,661,045) is calculated in accordance with

AS 14.17.410(b)(2) based upon the full and true value of property in the borough, as determined by the Department of Commerce, Community & Economic Development as of January 1, 2024. The required contribution is calculated as follows.

Required Local Contribution Computation (AS 14.17.410(b)(2))

DCRA full and true value per correspondence dated October 1, 2024 \$18,740,016,879

2.65 mills equivalent: Required Contribution \$49,661,045

Passage of Resolution Serial No. 25-041 fulfills the requirements of AS 14.14.060(c) and MSB 3.04.020(B). Additionally, Resolution Serial No. 25-041 provides a mechanism for increasing local support for school purposes once the full status of state funding of local governments is determined. The purpose of Resolution No. 25-041 is not to restrict the amount of "local support" for school operations, but to provide the assembly with a degree of flexibility. Much of the information necessary for an informed decision on the budget is still unknown at the time this resolution was prepared.

The Borough assembly provided \$75,031,853 in local support for education in fiscal year 2025. In addition, \$7,263,913 was provided for net debt service for the school construction and improvement bonds. This funding equated to 5.874 mills for local support of education.
