**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 18-096**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROPRIATING OF \$53,000 FROM THE 2006 SERIES A GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND INTEREST ACCOUNT 400 PROJECT 65002.5307, TO KNIK AND GOOSE BAY ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS ACCESS FENCING ACCOUNT 400, PROJECT NO. 40161

WHEREAS, the Knik and Goose Bay Elementary Schools have a common play-scape area behind the schools that are being accessed and vandalized by vehicular motorized vehicles; and

WHEREAS, these areas are for student and pedestrian access only; and

WHEREAS, the vehicles are causing harm to the vegetation, soccer fields, play-scape and is also a safety concern for student and pedestrian users; and

WHEREAS, funds are being requested to remedy this situation by installing fencing to prevent unauthorized motorized vehicle access; and

WHEREAS, no expenditures can be made until a scope of work and budget have been approved by Assembly for the requested funds.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. There is hereby appropriated \$ 53,000 to fund 400, from the 2006 Series A General Obligation Bond interest, account 400, project no. 65002.5307 for the essential funds needed for the Knik and Goose Bay Elementary Schools access fencing, project no. 40161.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
