I move to amend Ordinance Serial No. 19-090 as follows:

1) To change the title of the Ordinance and IM to read:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY CHANGING THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY MEMBERS TO A MAXIMUM OF THREE CONSECUTIVE, FULL TERMS AND SUBMITTING THE ISSUE TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS AT THE NOVEMBER 5, 2019, REGULAR BOROUGH ELECTION.

- 2) To delete Sections 3 and 5 from the ordinance and remove all references to Sections 3 and 5 of the ordinance.
- 3) To amend Section 2 of the ordinance to read:

Term of office. The assembly members' term shall be three years. The qualified candidate succeeds to the candidate's elected office the first Monday following the certification of the election and acceptance of the oath of office. No person shall serve on the assembly for more than [TWO] three consecutive, full terms.

4) To change to corresponding ballot question to read:

PROPOSITION NO. _____

Changing Future Borough Assembly Members' term limits to three consecutive full terms.

Shall Future Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly Members be limited to serving three, consecutive full terms?

This change would not apply to the current Borough Assembly members, who will be limited to two consecutive, full terms.

5) To add another non-code section to the ordinance to read:

Section 7. Application to current Assembly Members. The provisions of this ordinance do not apply to Assembly Members currently in office regardless of whether they are in their first or second term. Assemblymembers currently in office are limited to two consecutive, full terms and cannot serve a third term consecutive to the current first or second term.
