SUMMARY STATEMENT:

In the 2019 Capital Projects Budget \$146,000 was appropriated to put a repeater in the Lake Louise area. Due to operational changes, it has been determined that a repeater in this area is no longer necessary.

We are currently losing our communications lease site in the Palmer/Sutton area and will need to find another location. Rather than leasing another site, re-appropriating the funding from the Lake Louise repeater project would enable the borough to own, operate, and maintain their own communications site in the Palmer/Sutton area. Installing a tower in the Palmer/Sutton area will better serve borough residents by providing a more efficient, stable, and sustainable communication system.

The Emergency Services Director has requested that the Lake Louise Repeater funding be re-appropriated as a communications

site project for the Palmer/Sutton area.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION:

The administration supports this legislation, which will amend the scope of work for project 47525 to place a tower and communications building and equipment in the Sutton/Palmer area.
