## MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 25-021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$60,000 FROM THE UNITED STATES FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE, NATIONAL FISH HABITAT PARTNERSHIP FOR COAL CREEK AT SUSHANA DRIVE FISH PASSAGE REPLACEMENT.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale of this ordinance are in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 25-042 and Resolution Serial No. 25-016.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. The Assembly hereby accepts \$60,000 from the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, National Fish Habitat Partnership, and appropriates \$60,000 to fund 410, project no. 30114, fish passage improvements.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
