STATION 6-2 TRAINING PAD SCOPE OF WORK

General

This project's purpose is to construct a paved training pad for fire personnel to be used for emergency vehicle driver training and other training opportunities. This project will involve, but is not limited to, clearing and grubbing, excavation, import and placement of borrow material, import and placement of aggregate base course, placing hot mix asphalt, constructing lined ditches and rock check dams, installing a drainage culvert, and placing topsoil and seed.

This project is in Wasilla near the Knik Goose Bay Road and Vine Road intersection. See project location and vicinity maps.

All construction shall be completed in accordance with the current Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Standard Specifications for Highway Construction (SSHC) 2017 Edition. Project specific special provisions are provided in the following sections. The requirements contained in these specifications and special provisions are hereby made a part of this solicitation and resultant contract.

Work Description

- Supply labor, equipment, materials and supplies to perform the required work as shown on the construction plans.
