ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 22-027**

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$700,000 FOR THE CASWELL,
BIRCH, AND CROCKER CREEKS FISH PASSAGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale of this ordinance are in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 22-054.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. There is here by accepted and appropriated by the Assembly \$700,000 from the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, to fund 410, project No. 30114, for the Caswell, Birch, and Crocker Creeks Fish Passage Improvements project.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
