SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Public Works Department had purchased drum rollers, a crack sealer, a sweeper and fencing with Road Service Area Funds through the budget process. The fencing project is complete, and the leftover material was not needed for any other projects. The crack sealer and drum rollers were purchased to complete projects in-house. Over time, the increasing maintenance costs had proven to be costly, and the required manpower was not sustainable. In fiscal year 2024 these items were placed on the surplus sale site and sold for a total of \$164,350.

The Public Works Department is recommending appropriation of a portion of fund balance, Fund 265 to project no. 30092 to purchase a Trailer Mounted Asphalt Recycler. This asphalt recycler uses old asphalt and a liquid additive that will allow pothole patching to take place winter and summer, twenty-four hours a day at an estimated cost of \$54 per ton. Currently the road maintenance division spends approximately \$495 per ton to purchase Perma Patch for winter pothole patching. Asphalt used for summer pothole patching costs \$89 per ton and can only be obtained through an asphalt plant.

The Trailer Mounted Asphalt Recycler will address cost effectiveness and efficiency for asphalt patching work performed by the Public Works Department.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: Respectfully request adoption of this legislation as presented.
