A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR THE SAFE STREETS FOR ALL ACTION PLAN PROJECT; AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION GRANT MATCH PROJECT; AND AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION.
