RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 19-033**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR THE FOLSOM DRIVE TO BOGARD ROAD CONNECTING PATHWAY, PROJECT NO. 35299, FUND 430.

---

WHEREAS, the Bogard Road Extension East project created a parallel, separated pathway that provides a connection from the Glenn Highway in Palmer to Colony Middle School; and

WHEREAS, the pathway receives daily use from surrounding neighborhoods, two high schools, and a middle school; and

WHEREAS, there is a significant amount of Equestrian Acres and Equestrian Glen community members who now walk along Folsom Drive to access the pathway; and

WHEREAS, Folsom Drive has no shoulder or safe walking zone and only an unimproved dirt path extending through the ditch connecting to the pathway; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has submitted a grant application to the Mat-Su Trails and Parks Foundation for funds to construct an 8-foot wide connecting pathway with curb, to provide a safe area along Folsom Drive from Equestrian Street to the pathway; and

WHEREAS, a culvert and level fill will be installed in the ditch for the 8-foot wide connecting pathway to traverse, again allowing for improved, safe access; and

WHEREAS, the Equestrian Homeowners Association met in August 2018 and voted to provide \$2,500 towards the construction of the connecting pathway; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance Serial No. 19-043 accepted and appropriated a \$2,500 donation from the Equestrian Homeowners Association; and

WHEREAS, no expenditures can be made until a scope of work and budget has been approved by the Assembly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the following scope of work and budget for development of the Folsom Drive to Bogard Road Connecting Pathway.

#### **SCOPE OF WORK**

Construct an 8'wide connecting pathway along Folsom Drive from Equestrian Street to the pathway. A culvert and level fill will be installed in the ditch for the connecting pathway to traverse.
