MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 25-105

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING MSB 5.25.038, SERVICE AREA NO. 24: TALKEETNA FIRE SERVICE AREA; ANNEXING PARCELS LOCATED IN THE AREA OF EAST ROLLIE L CIRCLE, SOUTH LEROY DAVIES ROAD, AND RIDDLE AVENUE INTO THE TALKEETNA FIRE SERVICE AREA WITHOUT THE PLACEMENT OF THE QUESTION ON THE BALLOT AND FINDING THAT IT SERVES THE PUBLIC INTEREST.

WHEREAS, a petitioner has come forward requesting annexation of eight parcels located on East Rollie L. Circle and South Leroy Davies Road into the Talkeetna Fire Service Area; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner has secured 62.5 percent of the signatures of the real property owners in the proposed area, and the petition has been certified by the Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Talkeetna Fire Service Area Board of Supervisors is in favor of the annexation; and

WHEREAS, A.S. 29.35.450(C) and MSB 5.20.005(G) allows for the annexation of property into a fire service area without placing the question of the annexation on the ballot if the result in increasing the number of parcels of land is not more than 6 percent and would not add more than 1,000 residents; and

WHEREAS, according to the best available assessment data, this annexation would be adding 8 parcels to the existing fire

service area of 2,410 parcels and would increase the total number of residents by nine.

WHEREAS, the Manager considers the proposed annexation to be feasible and serving the public's interest, as the proposed annexation would provide fire coverage to the property, which is required by MSB 5.10.050; and

WHEREAS, the cost of services is 2.846 mills or \$284.60 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation as adopted by the Assembly in the fiscal year 2026 budget.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Borough Code.

Section 2. <u>Amendment of section</u>. MSB 5.25.038 is hereby amended to read as follows:
