SUMMARY STATEMENT: In accordance with code, the District preliminary budget was due to the Assembly on April 1, 2024. The budget was received April 4, 2024.

The total school district budget request is \$263,567,308. Of that amount, they have made the request that \$75,038,853 be provided by the Borough. Resolution Serial No. 24-050 will establish the minimum amount of money from local sources to be made available for school purposes. That amount is \$47,177,910, which is the required Borough (local) contribution. This minimum required local contribution amount (\$47,177,910) is calculated in accordance with AS 14.17.410(b)(2) based upon the full and true value of property in

the borough, as determined by the Department of Commerce, Community & Economic Development as of January 1, 2023. The required contribution is calculated as follows.

2.65 mills equivalent: Required Contribution

\$47,177,910

Passage of Resolution Serial No. 24-050 fulfills the requirements of AS 14.14.060(c) and MSB 3.04.020(B). Additionally, Resolution Serial No. 24-050 provides a mechanism for increasing local support for school purposes once the full status of state funding of local governments is determined. The purpose of Resolution No. 24-050 is not to restrict the amount of "local support" for school operations, but to provide the assembly with a degree of flexibility. Much of the information necessary for an informed decision on the budget is still unknown at the time this resolution was prepared.

The Borough assembly provided \$72,846,459 in local support for education in fiscal year 2024. In addition, \$7,862,018 was provided for net debt service for the school construction and improvement bonds. This funding equated to 6.121 mills for local support of education.
