WHEREAS, the Alaska State Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreations, Office of History and Archaeology has awarded a Certified Local Government Grant in the amount of \$25,000 to the Borough; and

WHEREAS, this grant is intended to cover a portion of the funding necessary for the stabilization of the Rebarchek Colony Farm house; and

WHEREAS, the Rebarchek Colony Farm house was the first farm house constructed in the Colony and is of great historic significance to the Borough; and

WHEREAS, it is our intention to use \$16,667 of these funds to meet the required match for this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby approves the scope of work and budget for the Rebarchek Colony Farm Certified Local Government Grant.
