**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 18-030**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY
ESTABLISHING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR THE REBARCHEK COLONY
FARM CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Department of Natural Resources,
Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreations, Office of History and
Archaeology has awarded a Certified Local Government Grant in the
amount of \$25,000 to the Borough; and

WHEREAS, this grant is intended to cover a portion of the
funding necessary for the stabilization of the Rebarchek Colony
Farm house; and

WHEREAS, the Rebarchek Colony Farm house was the first farm
house constructed in the Colony and is of great historic
significance to the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has partnered with the Alaska State
Fair to ensure the Rebarchek Colony Farm house is preserved for
the benefit of all residents; and

WHEREAS, the state of Alaska requires a 40 percent cash
match, equaling \$16,667, for this grant program; and

WHEREAS, in the Fiscal Year 2016 Capital Projects budget the

Assembly appropriated \$190,000 in Areawide fund for Grant Match; and

WHEREAS, it is our intention to use \$16,667 of these funds to meet the required match for this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby approves the scope of work and budget for the Rebarchek Colony Farm Certified Local Government Grant.

SCOPE OF WORK

The Matanuska-Susitna Borough will work with the Alaska State Fair on the Stabilization of the Rebarchek Colony Farm.
