**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 18-082**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$40,000 FROM THE ALASKA STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES GRANT PROGRAM, TO FUND 425, PROJECT NO. 45284, FOR SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT, AND PERSONNEL COSTS TO ALLOW FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION AND MANAGEMENT OF POINTS OF DISPENSING AND MEDICAL COUNTERMEASURES.

WHEREAS, the Borough has been awarded an Alaska State Department of Health and Social Services grant in the amount of \$40,000; and

WHEREAS, funding will be used for supplies, equipment, and personnel costs to allow for the implementation and management of points of dispensing and medical countermeasures; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work and budget are contained in Resolution Serial N. 18-053; and

WHEREAS, the assembly must accept and appropriate the \$40,000 from the Alaska State Department of Health and Social Services prior to the expenditure of said funds; and

WHEREAS, no expenditures can be made until the scope of work and budget have been approved by the Assembly.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation source. The Assembly hereby accepts a grant in the amount of \$40,000 from the Alaska State Department of Health and Social Services grant program, and approves an appropriation in the amount of \$40,000 from the Alaska State Department of Health and Social Services grant program, to fund 425, project no. 45284, for supplies, equipment, and personnel costs to allow for the implementation and management of points of dispensing and medical countermeasures.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
