A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY
REACTIVATING THE GREATER FARM LOOP COMMUNITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, Section 2.76.040 (B) of the Borough code specifies that the Planning Department shall, at least once every three years, submit to the Planning Commission and Assembly a report and recommendation on community council boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department conducted a community council boundary review in 2008, and following that review, the Greater Farm Loop Community Council was declared inactive pursuant to MSB 2.76.030 (C); and

WHEREAS, in October 2016, the Planning Department received a request from Greater Farm Loop residents to reactivate their community council; and

WHEREAS, Greater Farm Loop residents have submitted all necessary documentation that they are in compliance with the requirements set forth in MSB 2.76 for recognition; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on May 1, 2017, and adopted Resolution No. 17-17 recommending Assembly approval of the reactivation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby reactivates the Greater Farm Loop community Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Assembly approves the boundaries of the Greater Farm Loop Community Council as reflected on Attachment "A" of this resolution.

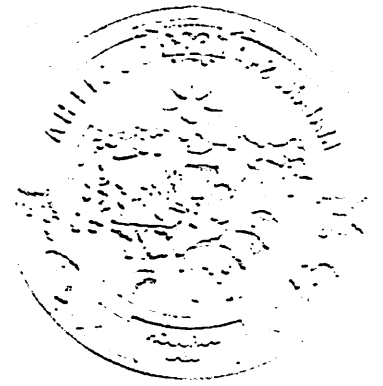

18 North	1 East	The north half, and the southeast one-quarter, and the north half of the southwest one-quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 24.
18 North	2 East	All of 16 lying west of the thread (center of the braided channels) of the Matanuska River.
18 North	2 East	All of 17, 18, 19, & 20.
18 North	2 East	All of 21 lying west of the thread (center of the braided channels) of the Matanuska River.
18 North	2 East	The northwest one-quarter of the northwest one-quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) lying west of the thread (center of the braided channels) of the Matanuska River of section 28.
18 North	2 East	The north half of the northeast one-quarter, and the northwest one-quarter, and the north half of the southwest one-quarter, excluding the City of Palmer (N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of section 29.
18 North	2 East	The north half and the north half of the south half (N $\frac{1}{2}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ S $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 30.
