SUMMARY STATEMENT: The accompanying resolution is at the request of Assembly member Fonov. This legislation directs the Manager to research and report on options of Borough-owned property for a possible less than fair market value sale to the YMCA of Alaska for a new multi-sport recreation facility.

DISCUSSION: The YMCA of Alaska has expressed interest in acquiring Borough-owned land at less than fair market value. The YMCA of Alaska plans to build a large recreation center in the core area featuring a fitness area, basketball courts, an Olympic-sized pool, childcare and group classes. The YMCA hopes to open the facility

within five years. The YMCA wants to provide more affordable recreation options to the community. The YMCA offers several programs throughout the state including a 75,000 square foot recreation, fitness, and pool facility in Anchorage. The organization is funded through grants and donations.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: Adoption of Resolution 25-107 directing the staff to begin the process of a less than fair market value land sale to the YMCA of Alaska.
