MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 17-024

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$21,580 FROM THE ALASKA STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES GRANT PROGRAM, TO FUND 425, PROJECT NO. 45284, FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE MATERIALS, PLANNING, TRAINING AND EXERCISE, AS WELL AS PERSONNEL COSTS FOR COORDINATING THE SUPPORT OF THE EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Borough received a grant from the Alaska State

Department of Health and Social Services; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly accepted and appropriated funds in the amount of \$40,000 with the approval of Ordinance Serial No. 16-093, and approved the scope of work and budget with Resolution Serial No. 16-060; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has received additional funding on this grant from the Alaska State Department of Health and Social Services; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly must accept and appropriate the additional grant funds in the amount of \$21,580 from the Alaska State Department of Health and Social Services grant prior to the expenditure of said funds; and

WHEREAS, the funds will be used for emergency response materials, planning, training, and exercise, as well as personnel

costs for coordinating the support of the Emergency Operations Plan; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work and budget are contained in Resolution Serial No. 17-017; and

WHEREAS, no expenditures can be made until the scope of work and budget have been approved by the Assembly.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and appropriation source. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby accepts a grant in the amount of \$21,580 from the Alaska State Department of Health and Social Services grant program, and approves an appropriation in the amount of \$21,580 from the Alaska State Department of Health and Social Services grant program, to fund 425, project no. 45284, for emergency response materials, planning, training, and exercise, as well as personnel costs for coordinating the support of the Emergency Operations Plan.

Section 3. <u>Effective date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
