




**SUMMARY STATEMENT:**

On October 18, 2022 the Assembly accepted a grant from the United States Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration for the Gateway Visitor Center Construction.

At that time, staff failed to include the time extension on the match funding that was included in the approved budget. This legislation will extend the match funding through the life of the grant, May 31, 2027.

The borough received a letter of commitment from the Mat-Su Convention and Visitors Bureau committing to the provision of \$156,030.00 in funding as match for the Federal Grant. When received, this funding was given an expiration of June 30, 2024. Since this funding was specified as match, it will also be extended

through May 31, 2027. The source, project/sub-project, funding amounts, and current expiration dates are shown in the table below.
