BID 24-066B PROVIDE DIRECT INTERNET ACCESS AT THE DSJ BUILDING SPECIFICATIONS/SCOPE OF SERVICES

Introduction

The Matanuska-Susitna Borough (MSB) is a government agency headquartered in Palmer, Alaska. There are over 100,000 residents serviced by the Borough's 800 employees and Enterprise Network. The Mat-Su Borough provides Internet connectivity at most of the Borough's fifty-two physical locations from a central location.

The Mat-Su Borough has a single 1Gbps direct internet connection providing service via a WAN to other Mat-Su Borough locations.

The term length for this agreement is for three years with two additional one-year renewal periods (potentially five-year contract), subject to annual appropriation of funds by the Borough Assembly. The initial contract period of performance begins upon contract execution, July 1, 2024 and will end on June 30, 2027.

The Borough is seeking bids from broadband providers that have infrastructure and resources to provide:

- Direct Internet Access connectivity at the Mat-Su Brough DSJ Administration Building located at 350 E Dahlia Palmer, AK 99645.
- Upon request from the Borough, the apparent successful vendor must provide a description of implementation process specifically addressing any network outages or cutover time to implement the services and documentation related to performance guarantees, including uptime and service outage response time.

Scope of Services

It is the overall intent of this proposal to provide a Direct Internet Access Circuit (DIA) that meets the Borough's current level of service and is scalable as demands for bandwidth and quality of service change. The Mat-Su Borough requires that the service be delivered with a static /26 CIDR Public IP address Space.

The Mat-Su Borough requires internet service with unlimited usage as well as assurance that the provider will not deprioritize MSB traffic and/or otherwise prioritize other internet traffic above that of the Mat-Su Borough.

The Mat-Su Borough reserves the right to negotiate interim smaller circuits with the successful proposer to accommodate a phased installation approach. Please provide pricing for the speeds indicated in the table below in the space provided in Attachment 1: Cost Proposal.

Mat-Su Borough:

1. MSB would provide the space and power to an established demarc for any vendor infrastructure.

The end result of this engagement will be:

1. A direct internet access circuit placed at requested MSB Administration Building.

The engagement will include but is not limited to

- 1. Project Communication
 - a. Status reporting and project communications.
 - b. Review of existing hardware to verify capabilities.
 - c. Coordination of all circuit upgrades to minimize downtime.

2. Documentation

a. Complete network diagram showing Borough facilities and all related metro ethernet connections.

Deliverables

This bid would include graduated speed costs for the vendor to provide the Direct Internet Access services. The vendor would provide the underlying circuit and all hardware required to deliver the circuit at the location specified.

This proposal's overall intent is to provide Direct Internet Access service that meets our current level of service and is scalable as demands for bandwidth and service quality increase.

The provider must supply a CIDR /26 Public IP Address Space for the duration of the contract term.

The Mat-Su Borough reserves the right to negotiate interim smaller or larger circuits with the successful proposer to accommodate a scalable approach. Please provide pricing for the speeds available in the space provided in Attachment 1: Cost Proposal.

Internet Services speeds will be measured in bits (M, G), the circuit is required to be symmetrical download/upload, and usage must be unlimited.

The proposer shall be responsible for the installation and removal of all vendor equipment, which excludes the MSB-owned equipment being retained by the Mat-Su Borough. All costs related to such removal at the end of the contract shall be the responsibility of the contractor.

Complete specifications must be provided on all equipment or software offered. The MSB will provide adequate space and power in Main Distribution Facility (MDF) or designated location.

The service provider will notify the Mat-Su Borough of any occurrence whereby a data breach or leak may have resulted from any possible misconfiguration, equipment failure, or known compromise on the transport network.

The MSB will provide access to all networks and required for completion of the Scope of Services.

Schedule

This contract will begin on July 1, 2024 and end on June 30, 2027 for the initial 3-year term. There will be an option to renew for two additional one-year periods through June 30, 2029. Components may be developed and installed separately during the course of the services contract.

Cost

The proposed cost for the DIA circuit needs to be provided to the Borough.

These costs will include all recurring and non-recurring charges related to the circuit. Pricing should be presented based on a three (3) year contract.
