

SUMMARY STATEMENT: On July 22, 2020, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Purchasing Division issued a solicitation requesting bids from qualified contractors to pave a portion of Carmel Road. This project involves, but is not limited to: roadway and ditch reconditioning, culvert installation, import and placement of base course, and paving of the roadway and approaches on Carmel Road from This Way to Knick Knack Mud Shack Road. Services purchased will support the Public Works Department in assembly district #5.

In response to the advertisement, four bids were received. Award recommendation is being made to Western Construction & Equipment,

LLC as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder based on Total Bid Amount.

The substantial completion date for this project is September 25, 2020 with the final completion of October 1, 2020.

In accordance with MSB 3.08.170(B), Administration requests authority to modify the resulting contract completion date by 30 days for unforeseen circumstances.

The Public Works Department, Operations & Maintenance Division will be administering the contract.



SCOPE OF WORK

General

This project's purpose is to pave a portion of Carmel Road. This project involves, but is not limited to: roadway and ditch reconditioning, culvert installation, import and placement of base course, and paving of the roadway and approaches on Carmel Road from This Way to Knick Knack Mud Shack Rd.

All construction shall be completed in accordance with the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Standard Specifications for Highway Construction (SSHC) 2017 Edition. Project specific special provisions are provided in the following sections. The requirements contained in these specifications and special provisions are hereby made a part of this solicitation and resultant Contract.

Failure to comply with any work as described in this scope of work may be considered a material breach of the Contract, and is subject to termination as a result of non-compliance.

Work Description

- Supply labor, equipment, materials, and supplies to perform the required work as described herein and shown on the attached map.
- Contractor is required to call for utility locates prior to digging.
- Work Zone speed limit: Limit speed of vehicles associated with construction to 20 miles per hour within project limits.
- Use advance warning signs at each point of entry while construction is active.
- Provide traffic control and protect the HMA until temperatures are acceptable for vehicular traffic. A certified Traffic Control Supervisor is responsible for the set up and maintenance of the traffic control systems and devices utilized to ensure the safety of the workers and public. Traffic control shall comply with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) and all other applicable federal, state and local standards, laws, and regulations. Submit Traffic Control Plans for each road group for approval.
- Employee parking and equipment staging may be within the public right of way. Do not block private property access. A minimum of a 10-foot wide access must be maintained at all times. If private property is used by the Contractor to stage equipment, the Contractor must have a hold harmless agreement signed by the Contractor and property owner releasing MSB from liability for damage to that property.
- Normal work time is between 7 am and 7 pm. Extensions will be considered and approved by the Engineer.
- Time is of the essence. All work shall be complete by October 1, 2020. Submit a construction schedule at the pre-construction meeting.
- Finished pavement surface shall have a 2% crown.
- Typical road section is reconditioned full width (26' +/-), 2" thick Hot Mix Asphalt 22' wide, 3" thick D1 base 26' wide, D-1 gravel shoulders 2' wide.
- Ditch reconditioning is throughout project, both sides.
- Extra Ditching is to create ditches around This Way approach area, 150' east and 150' west.
- Culvert locations are shown on the attached map – 30' at This Way, 30' at 3 ea. driveways.
- Pave Carmel Rd. 50 feet west of Knick Knack Mud Shack approach.
- See attached map for work locations.
- Culvert markers will be installed by MSB, and are not included in this Contract.
